- ❑ Firstly, I want to help people. Nurse usually spends more time with patients than doctor does, and she can make the patient feel comfortable.

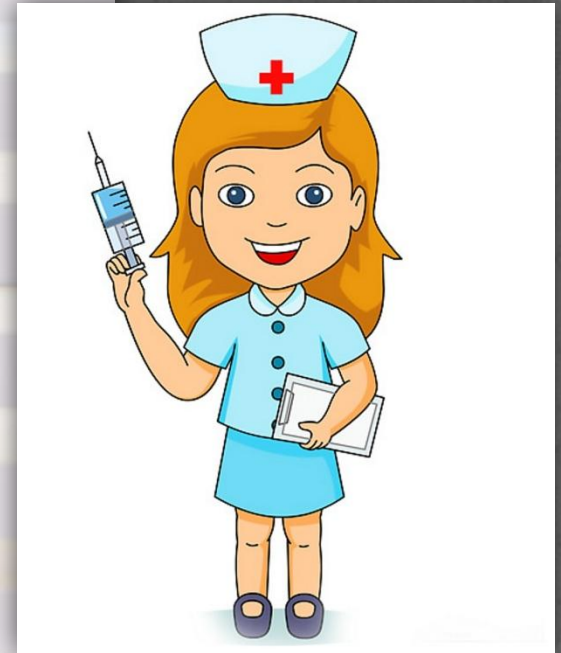


- ❑ Secondly, I find it useful in life. When I have a family, children, I will be able to provide them with basic medical care, will be able to care of my parents - they will get old soon too.
