

alcoholism, smoking and so on.**



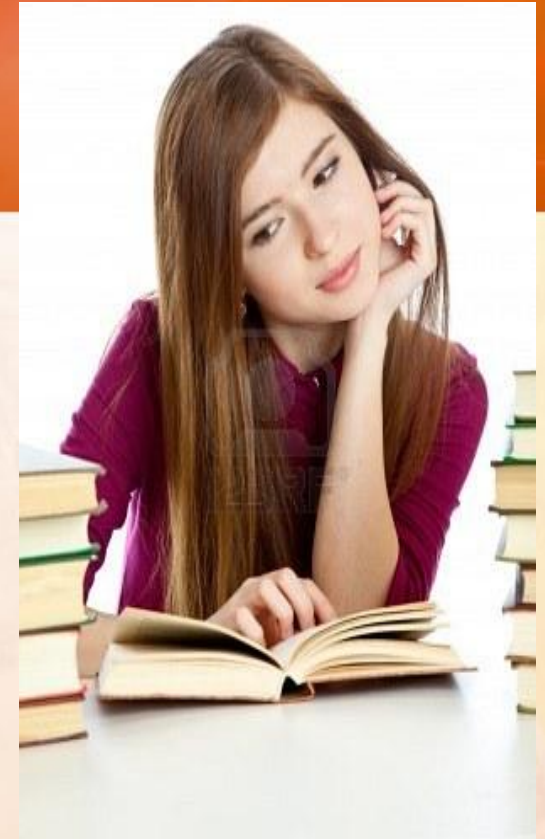
