# Celtic mythology

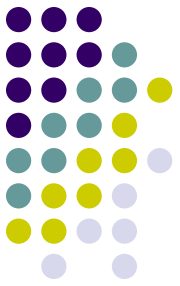

- Arts and Crafts became the main branch of Celtic art. Ingenious technique of processing from the beginning combined with ornaments and create valuable products.

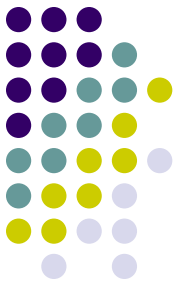


# Celtic ornaments
