# + History Painting



A genre in painting defined by its subject matter rather than artistic style. History paintings usually depict a moment in a narrative story, rather than a specific and static subject, such as a portrait.

# + A Portrait



Artistic representation of a person, in which the face and its expression is predominant. The intent is to display the likeness, personality, and even the mood of the person.

# + A genre painting



Represent scenes or events from everyday life, such as markets, domestic settings, interiors, parties, inn scenes, and street scenes.



# + Landscapes



The depiction of natural scenery such as mountains, valleys, trees, rivers, and forests, and especially art where the main subject is a wide view

# + Still Life



Art depicting mostly inanimate subject matter, typically commonplace objects
