The Houses of Parliament stands near the Thames. The country's leaders speak there.

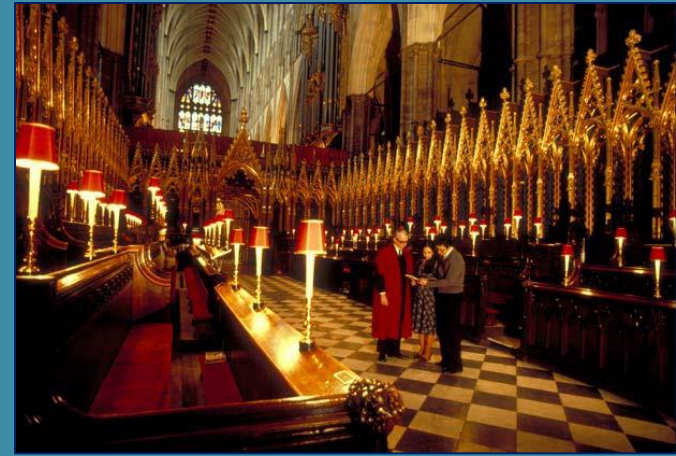


Big Ben
