Purposeful action of governments to integration



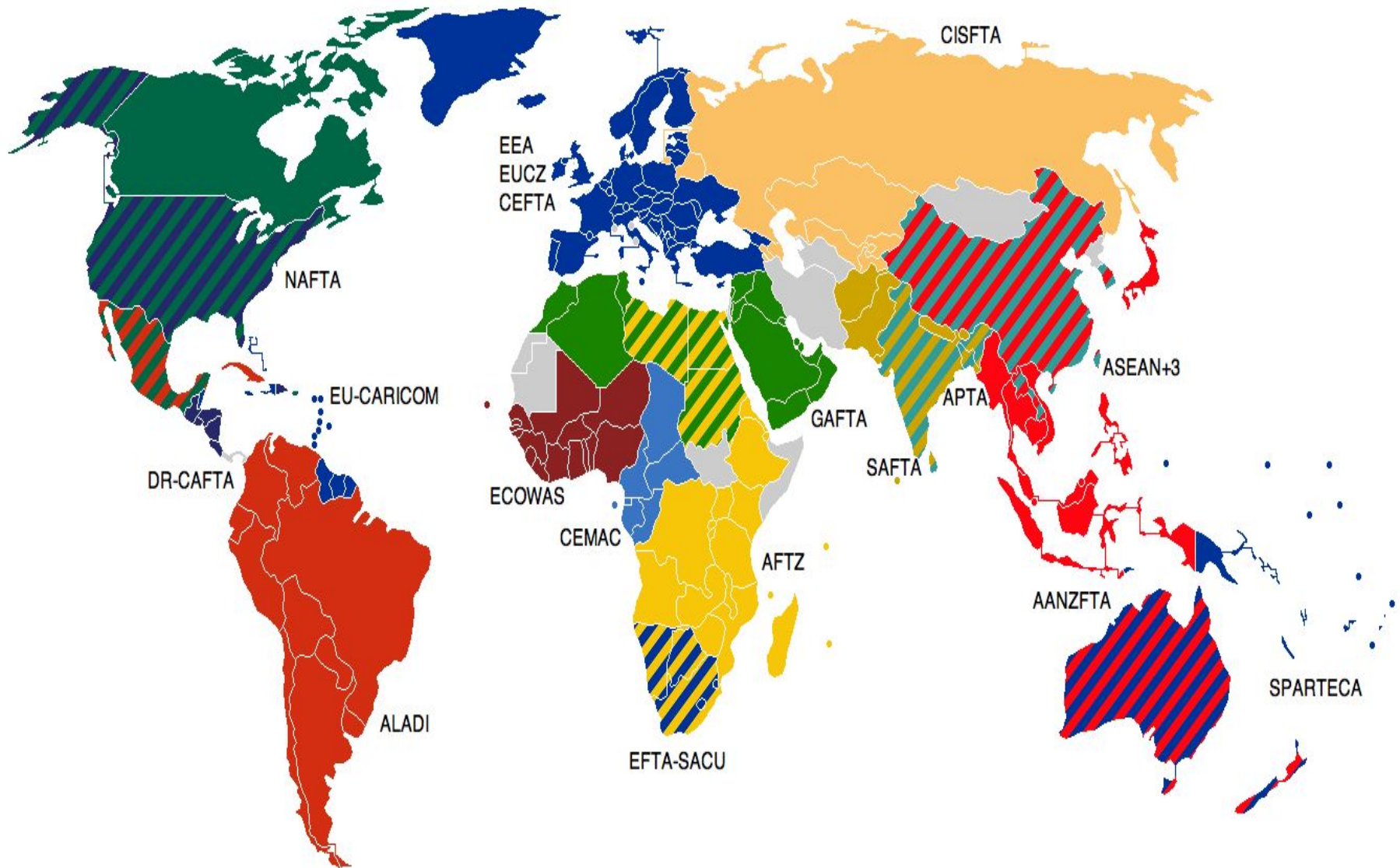
Worldwide using of Internet – cause of IT-sphere development



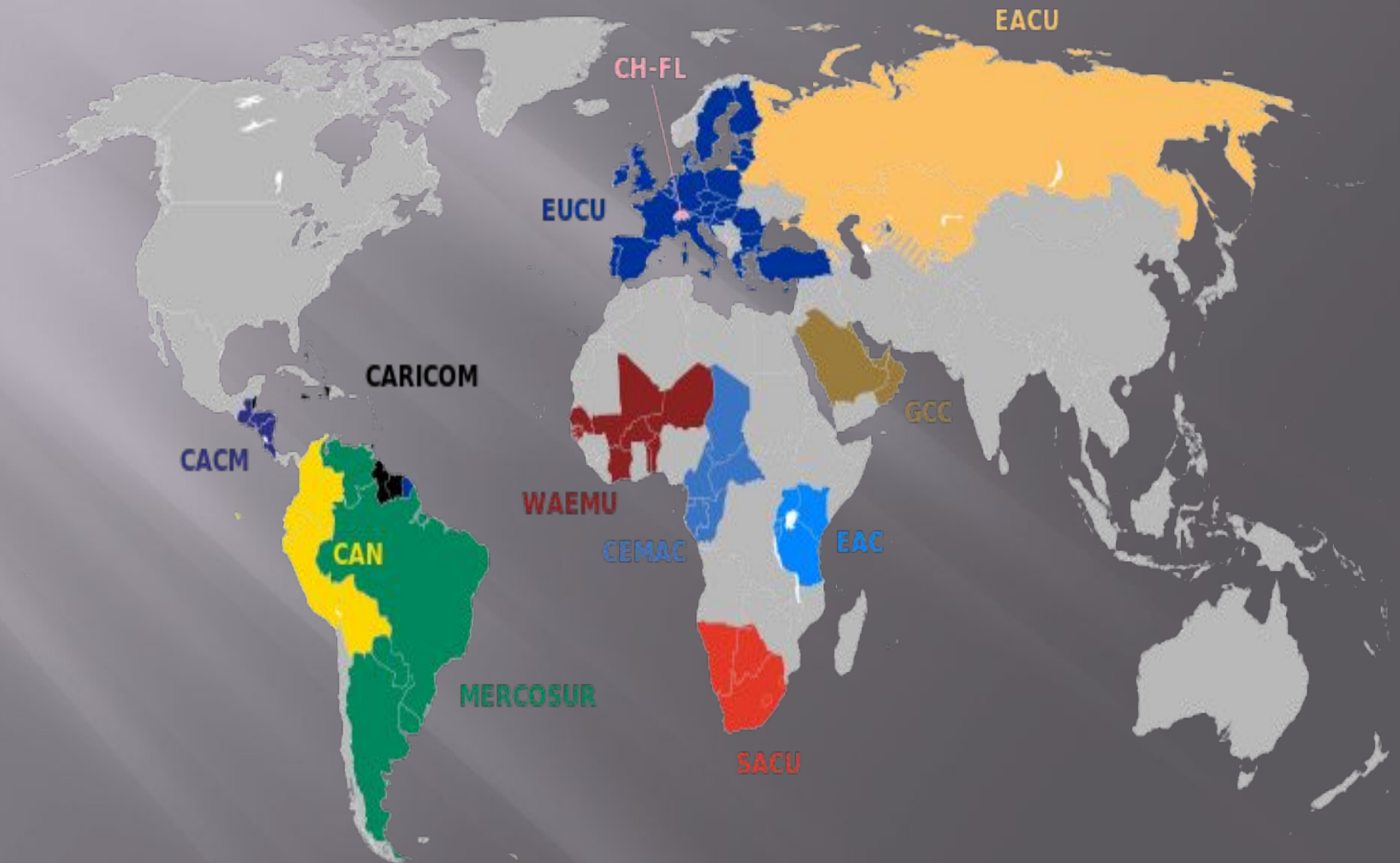
Forms of the economic globalization
