Are there any apples left?

HO! Would you like **some** tea?

A lot of/ lots of- в утверждениях <u>с исчисляемыми</u>

<u>и неисчисляемыми</u>

There's lots of rice in the bowl.

Many – <u>с исчисляемыми в вопросах и отрицаниях</u> во множ.числе.

I haven't got many pens.

Much- <u>с неисчисляемыми в вопросах и отрицаниях</u> I don't drink much coke.

Is there much tea in the pot?

#### мало

**Few** – <u>с исчисляемыми во множ.числе</u> We've got few potatoes. We need to buy some.

# Little- с неисчисляемыми

I have little time. I must be quick.

We've got little milk. Let's buy some.

## немного, несколько

A few- <u>с исчисляемыми во множ.числе</u> We've got a few lemons. We can make a lemon pie.

I've got a few pictures to show you.

A little- <u>с неисчисляемыми</u> I need a little time to think. There's a little honey in the jar left.
