Is (Was) there a cat in the house?

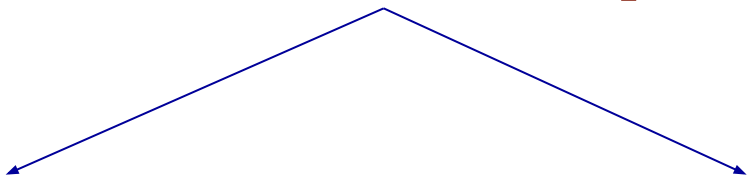
