PLACE OF BIRTH

- Leonardo Wilhelm DiCaprio was born in Los Angeles in November 1974 . His parents - my father George DiCaprio and his mother Irmelin Indenbirken - divorced a year after the birth of her son . Father worked as an artist and comic book distributor , soon married , but my mother did not come over to marry . She brought up her son and herself , torn between the two works

- the only child in the family. His parents divorced when he was a year old and he lived mostly with his mother, although his father was around intermittently. During his childhood, DiCaprio was interested in baseball cards, comic books, and frequently visited museums with his father.

CAREER

- DiCaprio's career began with his appearing in several commercials and educational films. He got his break on television in 1990 when he was cast in the short-lived series based on the movie Parenthood. His debut film role was Critters 3, a B-grade horror film, which later went straight to video.
- His breakthrough came in 1992, when he beat out hundreds of other boys for the role of Toby Wolff in This Boy's Life, co-starring Robert De Niro and Ellen Barkin. The move from "star" to "superstar" came when DiCaprio played Jack Dawson in the 1997 blockbuster Titanic, his popularity skyrocketed, with the media dubbing it "Leo-mania".
- In 2002, DiCaprio starred in Gangs of New York (directed by Martin Scorsese) and Catch Me If You Can (directed by Steven Spielberg). Both films were very well received by critics. DiCaprio continued his run with Scorsese in the 2006 film The Departed as Billy Costigan, a smart undercover cop in Boston. His next film was Blood Diamond, released in December 2006.

PERSONAL LIFE

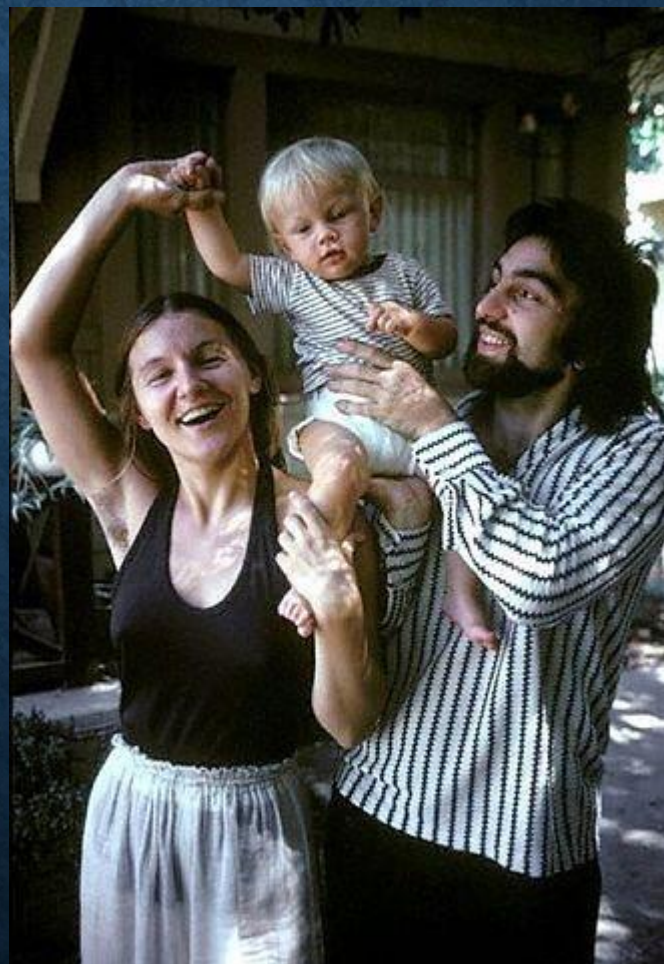
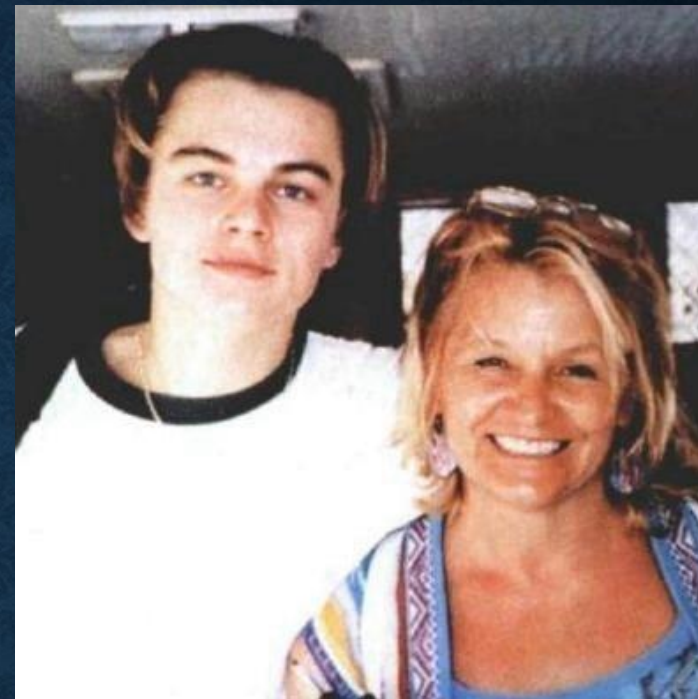
- Life Leonardo DiCaprio is widely covered in the media. In the 1990s Leonardo DiCaprio met with the Danish model Helena Christensen, from 2000 to 2005 - with the Brazilian model Gisele Bundchen [35], from 2006 to 2009, met with Israeli model Bar Refaeli. March 26, 2010 DiCaprio and Refaeli officially announced the break in relations. Since the summer of 2010 Leo and Bar began to meet again and have already planned to get married [37], but in May 2011 in the New York Post newspaper it was reported that Leonardo DiCaprio and Bar Refaeli finally parted

SUCCESS...

- An even greater success and money earned Leonardo DiCaprio in the film work of Martin Scorsese's "Gangs - New - York ." The film tells the story of clashes between criminal gangs immigrants and Americans . Another collaboration DiCaprio and Scorsese was a picture of "The Aviator" , which tells about the American businessman Howard Hughes . The tape had a huge success , and Leo was nominated for "Oscar" , which went to another actor .
