



The **sunflower seed** is the fruit of the <u>sunflower</u> (<u>Helianthus</u> <u>annuus</u>). The term "sunflower seed" is actually a <u>misnomer</u>). For commercial purposes, <u>sunflower</u> seeds are usually classified by the pattern on their husks. If the husk is solid black, the seeds are called black oil sunflower seeds. The crops may be referred to as oilseed sunflower crops. These seeds are usually pressed to extract their oil. Striped sunflower seeds are primarily used for food; as a result, they may be called confectionery sunflower seeds


