

New Zealand is a country in the southwestern Pacific ocean, in Polynesia, situated on two large Islands (North and South) and a large number (approximately 700) adjacent smaller Islands. The population, according to Statistics New Zealand for June 2015, is 4 596 700 people.

The country's capital — Wellington.

The state is built on the principles of constitutional monarchy and parliamentary democracy and is among the developed countries of the world. In the XI—XIV centuries the country was populated by immigrants from Polynesia, European explorers discovered the Islands in 1642. Active land development began Britain from 1762.





One of the main features of New Zealand is geographic isolation. The nearest neighbours of the country: West Australia, separated by the Tasman sea (the shortest distance is about 1,700 km); to the North of the island territory of New Caledonia (about 1400 km), Tonga (about 1800 km) and Fiji (about 1900 km).



English, Maori and new Zealand sign language are the official languages of the country.

English is the main language of communication, and 96 % of the population use it as such. Most books, Newspapers and magazines published on it, he dominates the broadcast radio and television. The Maori language is the second official language. In 2006 new Zealand sign language (New Zealand Sign Language) received the status of third official language.






Skycity Hotel

There are unique glowworms that illuminate the caves amazing blue-green. Thrill-seekers can go on a descent by water, and fans of choral singing to listen to acapella in the Cathedral hall on the night before Christmas.



The oldest national Park in the country, which is often called the "three Smoking mountain" due to the volcanoes located here. It is in Tongariro were shooting some scenes of the trilogy "the Lord of the rings", so the terrain here is really fantastic and fabulous. Subtropical forests, untouched by man, look not at all like the usual European trees.





Valley of geysers-Waimangu

This hydrothermal system was formed in 1886 and since then attracts tourists the opportunity to see two of the largest geyser in New Zealand — "the Feathers of the Prince of Wales" and Pohto. They erupt every twenty minutes, so that the long wait for the terrific't have to. The height of these geysers reach up to 30 meters.
