 Environmental resource management is the management of the interaction and impact of human societies on the environmental



ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCE MANAGEMENT GOALS:

- To ensure that ecosystem services are protected and maintained for future human generations
- Also maintain ecosystem integrity through considering ethical, economic, and scientific(ecological) variables
- To identify factors affected by conflicts that rise between meeting needs and protecting resources
