- - a feeling of great respect and admiration
- To be/stand in awe of sth/sb



BETRAY

- - to be disloyal or unfaithful to sth/sb
- To betray someone's trust/secret
- To betray one's beliefs or principles



CLAIM

- - to say that something is true, even through there is no definite proof
- -to say that sth is yours, especially as a right
- To claim to do sth



CONFIRM

- - to say or prove that sth is true
- To confirm sb's suspicious/fears



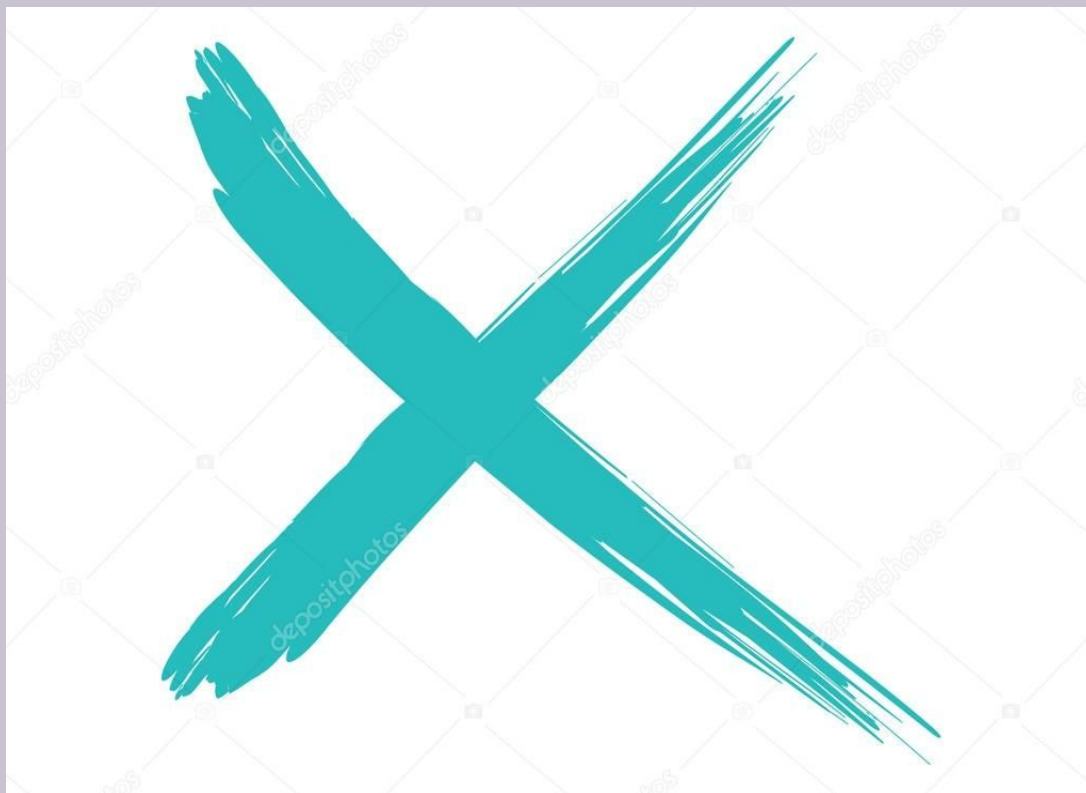
DEMAND

SENTENCE

- - to decide that someone must be given punishment
