## ***Listening Test Format - 30 minutes***

### **Section 1**

A conversation between two people set in an everyday social context.

### **Section 2**

A monologue set in an everyday social context e.g. a speech about local facilities.

### **Section 3**

A conversation between up to four people set in an educational or training context, e.g. a university tutor and a student discussing an assignment.

### **Section 4**

A monologue on an academic subject e.g. a university lecture.

## ***Reading Test Format - 60 minutes***

The Reading component consists of 40 questions. A variety of question types is used in order to test a wide range of reading skills. These including reading for gist, reading for main ideas, reading for detail, skimming, understanding logical argument, recognizing writers' opinions, attitudes and purpose.

### **IELTS Academic**

The Academic version includes three long texts which range from the descriptive and factual to the discursive and analytical. The texts are authentic and are taken from books, journals, magazines and newspapers.

## ***Writing Test Format - 60 minutes***

### **IELTS Academic**

The Writing component of IELTS Academic includes two tasks. Topics are of general interest to, and suitable for candidates entering undergraduate and postgraduate studies or seeking professional registration.

#### **Task 1**

You will be presented with a graph, table, chart or diagram and asked to describe, summarize or explain the information in your own words. You may be asked to describe and explain data, describe the stages of a process, how something works or describe an object or event.

#### **Task 2**

You will be asked to write an essay in response to a point of view, argument or problem. Responses to both tasks must be in a formal style.

## ***Listening Test Format – 11-14 minutes***

The Speaking component assesses your use of spoken English, and takes between 11 and 14 minutes to complete. Every test is recorded. The Speaking component is delivered in such a way that it does not allow candidates to rehearse set responses beforehand.

### **Part 1**

The Examiner will ask you general questions about yourself and a range of familiar topics, such as home, family, work, studies and interests. This part lasts between four and five minutes.

### **Part 2**

You will be given a card which asks you to talk about a particular topic. You will have one minute to prepare before speaking for up to two minutes. The examiner will then ask one or two questions on the same topic to finish this part of the test.

### **Part 3**

You will be asked further questions connected to the topic in Part 2. These questions will give you the opportunity to discuss more abstract ideas and issue. The part of the test lasts between four and five minutes.

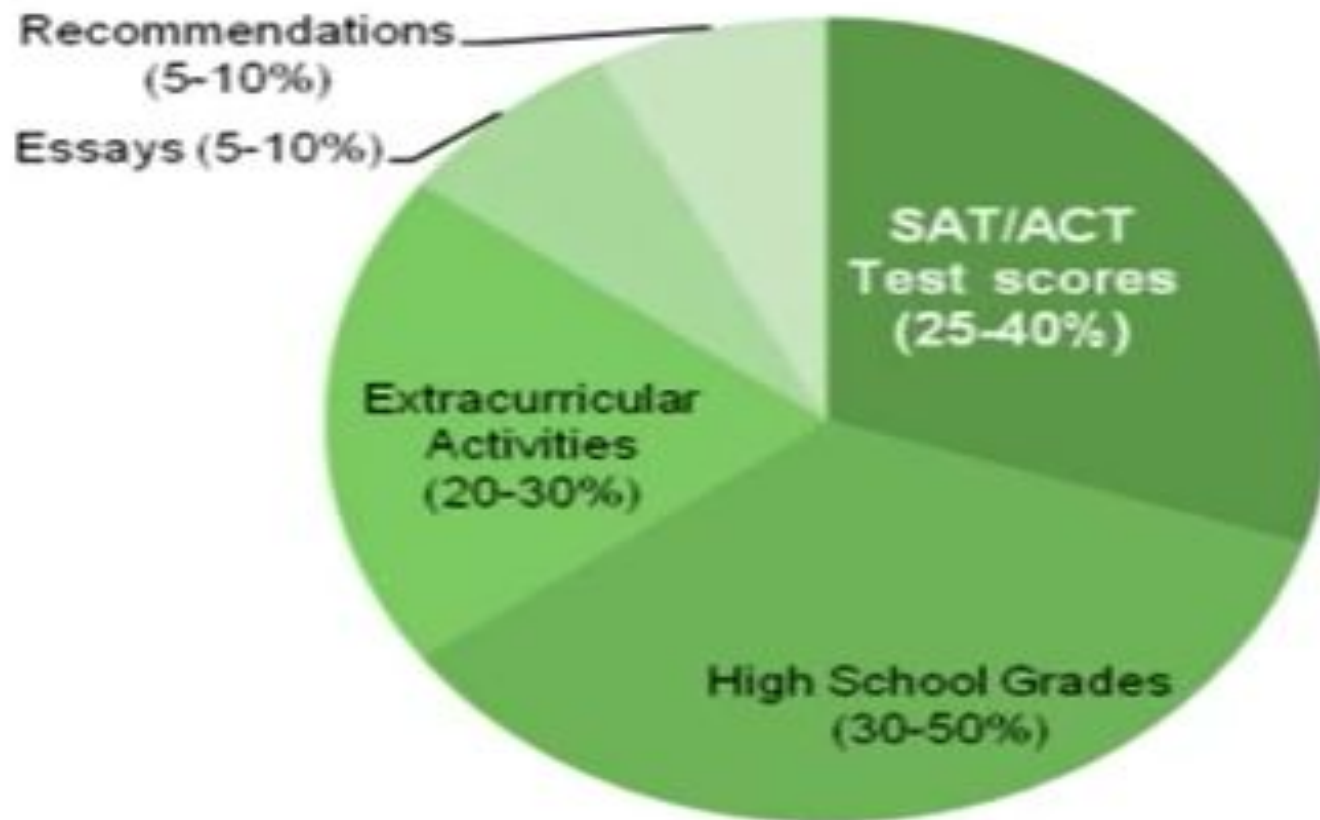

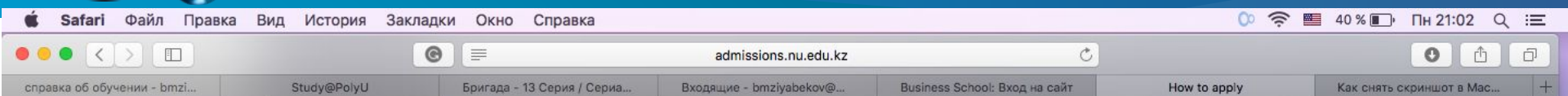

### 4. Two **letters of recommendation** from the academic institution where the applicant has studied:

The applicant should provide the University with two recommendation letters from two recommenders (instructor or head of the academic institution), who personally know the applicant and are capable to objectively assess their achievements, and potential for studies in the undergraduate programs in the competitive environment. Letter of recommendation should be sealed in the envelope and signed by the recommender across the flap. Either a recommender or an applicant should send the recommendation to the University. This Letter of Recommendation Form (please click [here](#) to download the document).

### 5. English language test results ([TOEFL](#) or [IELTS](#))

### 6. Test results ([SAT Reasoning Test](#) or [ACT with Writing Part](#) and/or [SAT Subject Test](#))

The applicant must send the standardized test results of SAT Reasoning Test, or ACT with Writing Part, SAT, IELTS. The tests should be sent to the University address via test administrator using the code (Institutional Code) of Nazarbayev University:

6762 - for TOEFL

7915 - for SAT

5521 - for ACT with Writing Part

### 7. Official **transcript** from the university in two languages: original language and English (for transfer students):

The applicants, who study in Kazakhstani universities and at the universities where English is not an academic language, should submit an original transcript officially translated into English.

Applicants or the university issuing the transcript should send the transcript to the NU's address. However, if the university is not in Kazakhstan, the applicant should notify the university about the submission deadlines.

### 8. Description of the courses taken (subjects) in two languages: original language and English (for transfer students)

Note: All documents sent to Nazarbayev University shall be the University's property and are not liable to return.







## HOW TO APPLY

### HOW TO APPLY

Applicants must go through the online registration process to sign up for the entry examinations to the Nazarbayev University Foundation Year Programme.

After completion of the [online registration](#), the registered applicants will be invited to participate in the three stages of the entrance examinations. Every stage of the entry examinations is administered by the partners of the Nazarbayev University.

#### 1st Stage

The APTIS examination is administered by the British Council. Applicants must bring ID card or passport (original, no photocopies accepted) for taking APTIS. To take a tentative APTIS please click [here](#).

The applicants with valid IELTS or TOEFL (PBT or iBT) certificate with overall passing score may be exempted from taking the APTIS test (1ststage). The TOEFL test scores should be sent directly from the TOEFL Testing Center to the Admissions Department of the University. The Nazarbayev University test code for the TOEFL examination is 6762.

#### 2nd Stage

The applicants, who have successfully passed APTIS, or with valid IELTS or TOEFL (PBT or iBT) certificate with overall passing score, will be invited to take the entrance examination, Nazarbayev University Foundation Year Programme Entrance Test-NUFYP Entrance Test, that evaluates core subjects' academic readiness for studying at the University.

Depending on chosen school where the applicant is planning to continue his/her studying after successful completion of the NUFYP, the NUFYP Entrance Test shall be held in two of the following subject sections: Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry/Biology, and Thinking Skills.

Each subject section consists of 30 multiple-choice questions. Duration of testing under each subject section is 60 minutes.

The NUFYP Entrance Test is assessed by standardized scale from 0 to 120 points for each subject section. The minimum passing level shall not be less than a standardised score of 60 on average for 2 (two) subjects, while the passing level for each of the subjects is not less than a standardised score of 50.

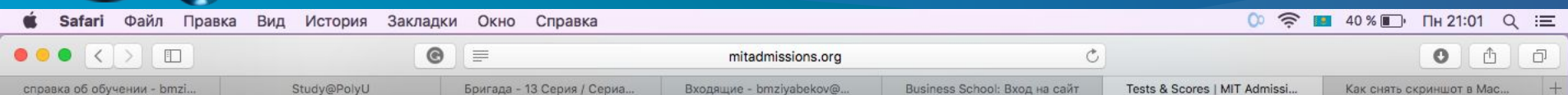

#### For native English speakers:

We require the SAT Reasoning Test *or* the ACT Plus Writing. *We do not prefer one over the other.* In addition, we require two SAT Subject Tests: one in math (level 1 or 2), and one in science (physics, chemistry, or biology e/m). We do not have a preference as to which science test you take or which math level you take.

#### For non-native English speakers:

You have two options: 1) take the tests required for native English speakers (see above) or 2) take the
