St. Valentine's Day has roots in several legends.**

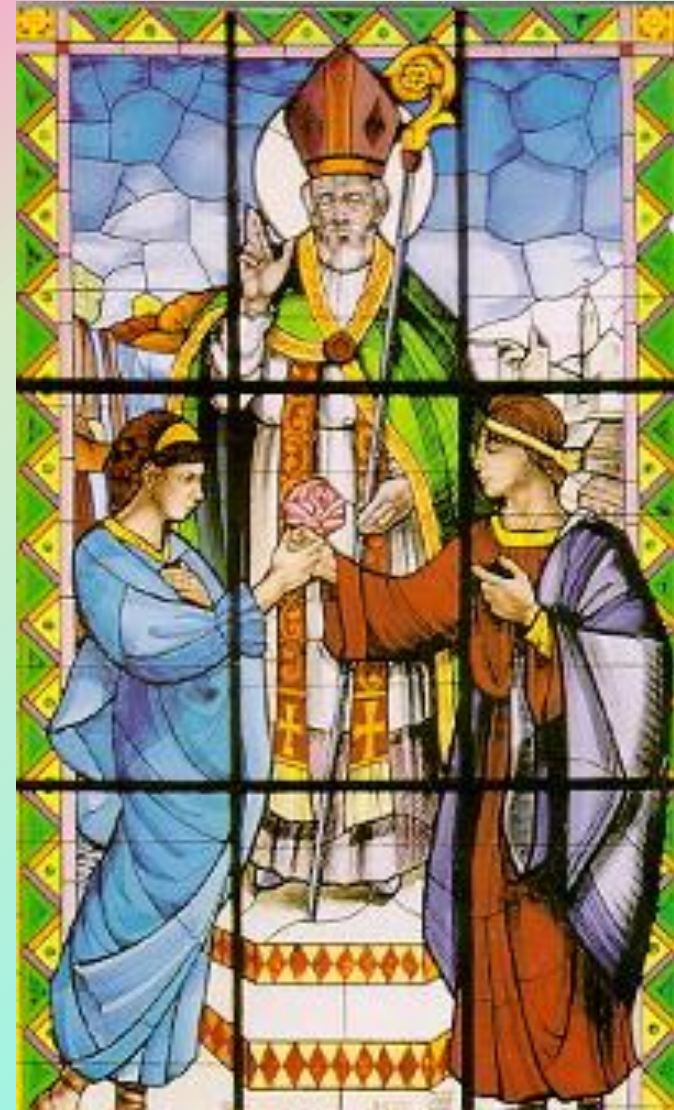
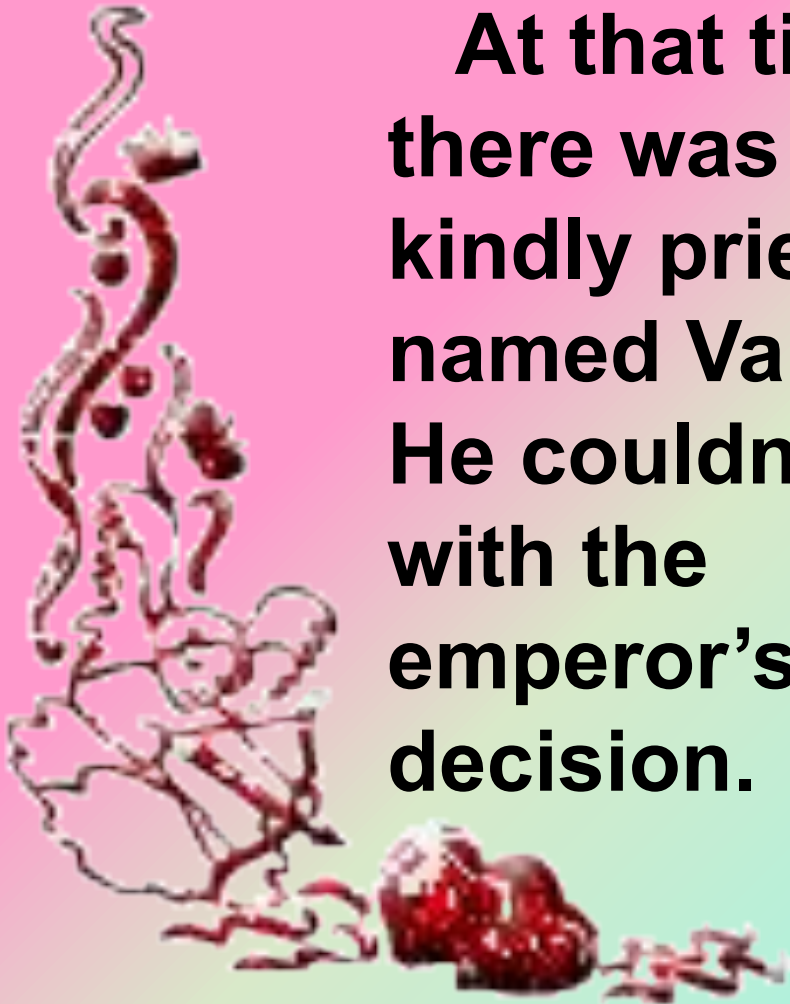

# CUPID



**One of the early symbols of love is Cupid, the Roman God of Love, who is represented as a young boy with a bow and arrows.**



# **ROSES**

One of the symbols of this day is a red rose.

This day people traditionally give these flowers. The Goddess of Love hurried to her lover and stepped on a bush with white roses.



She wounded her foot. Her blood made the rose red. Since that time the red roses are the symbol of love.





**The heart is the symbol of this day – the sweets are made in the form of heart, in the form of heart the cakes are baked. This day people send small paper hearts – the Valentines cards which always begin with “ I love you...”.**

# VALENTINE CARDS



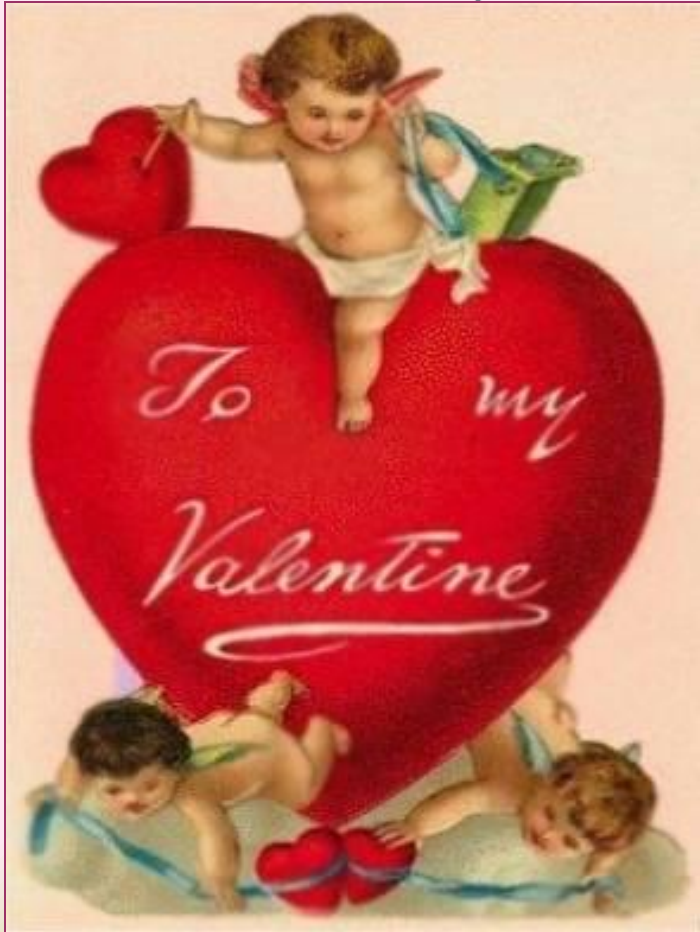




**On St. Valentine's Day

**She thought she would marry the man whose onion sprouted first.**









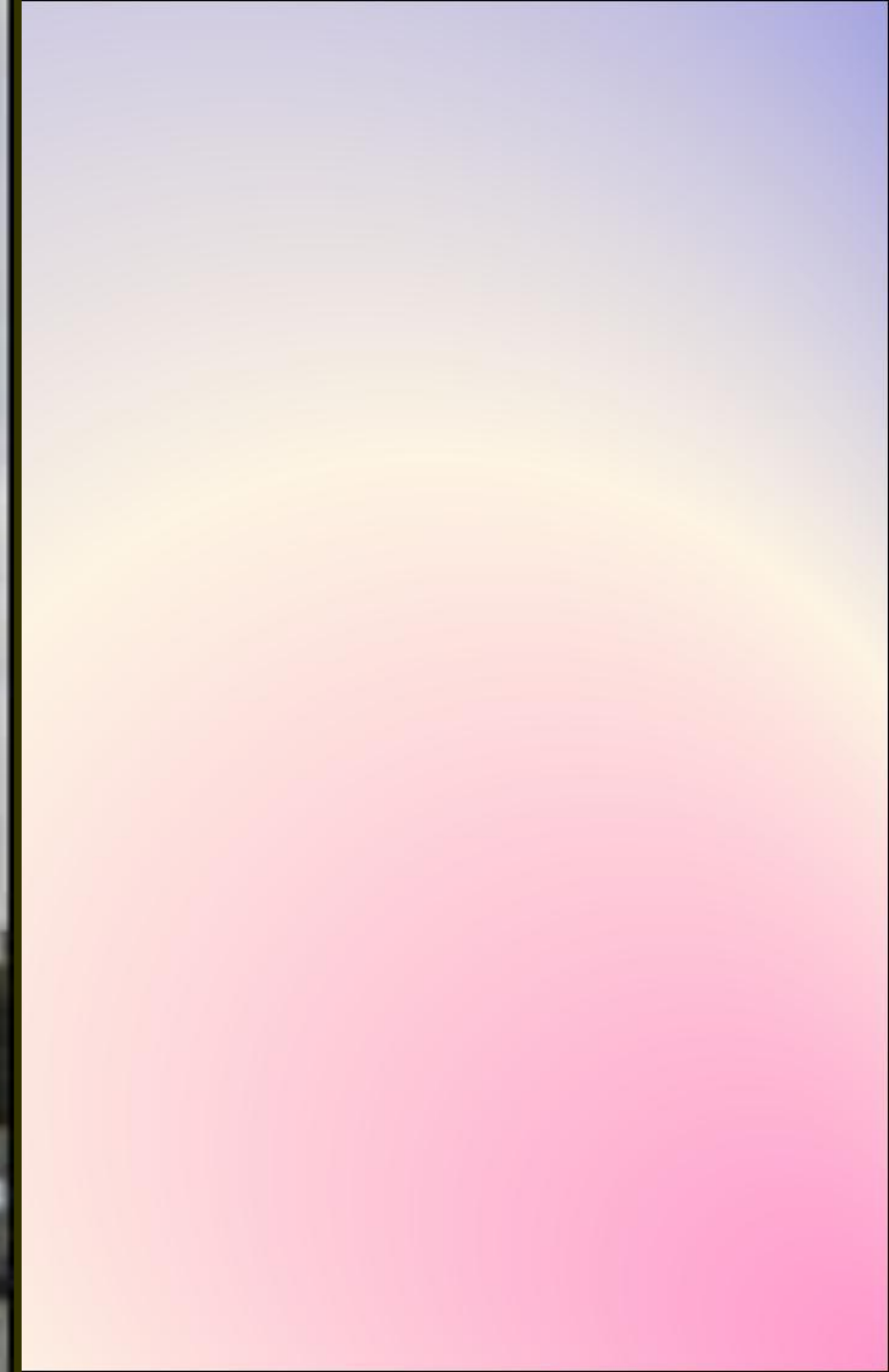


**St. Valentine's Day is a holiday for men.**
