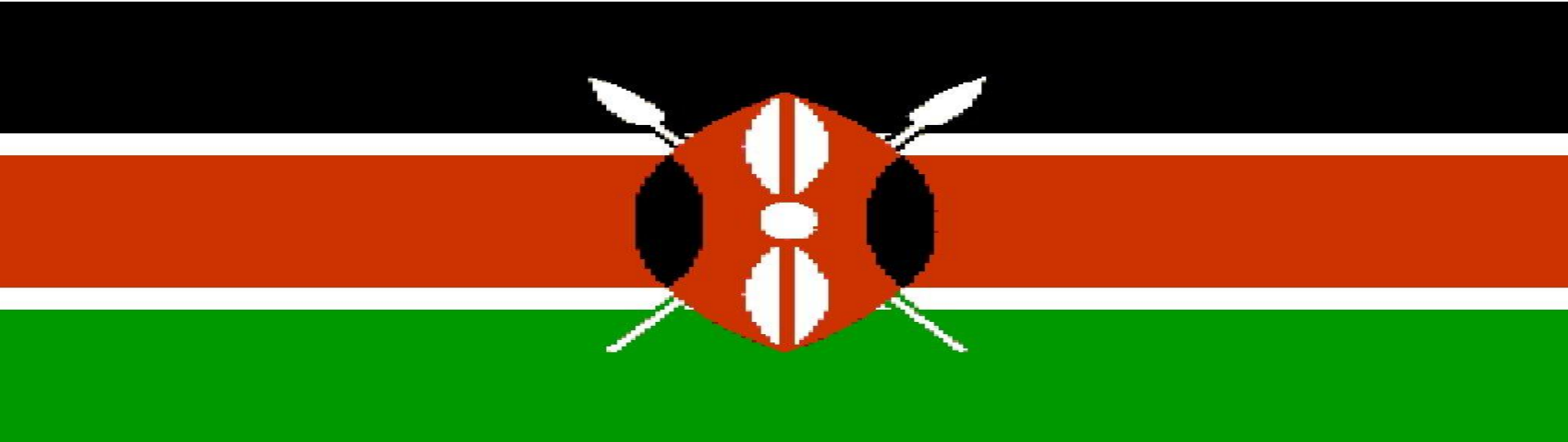

*Kenya has beautiful roads. The most beautiful highway in Kenya is Thika super highway. This is Thika super highway.*

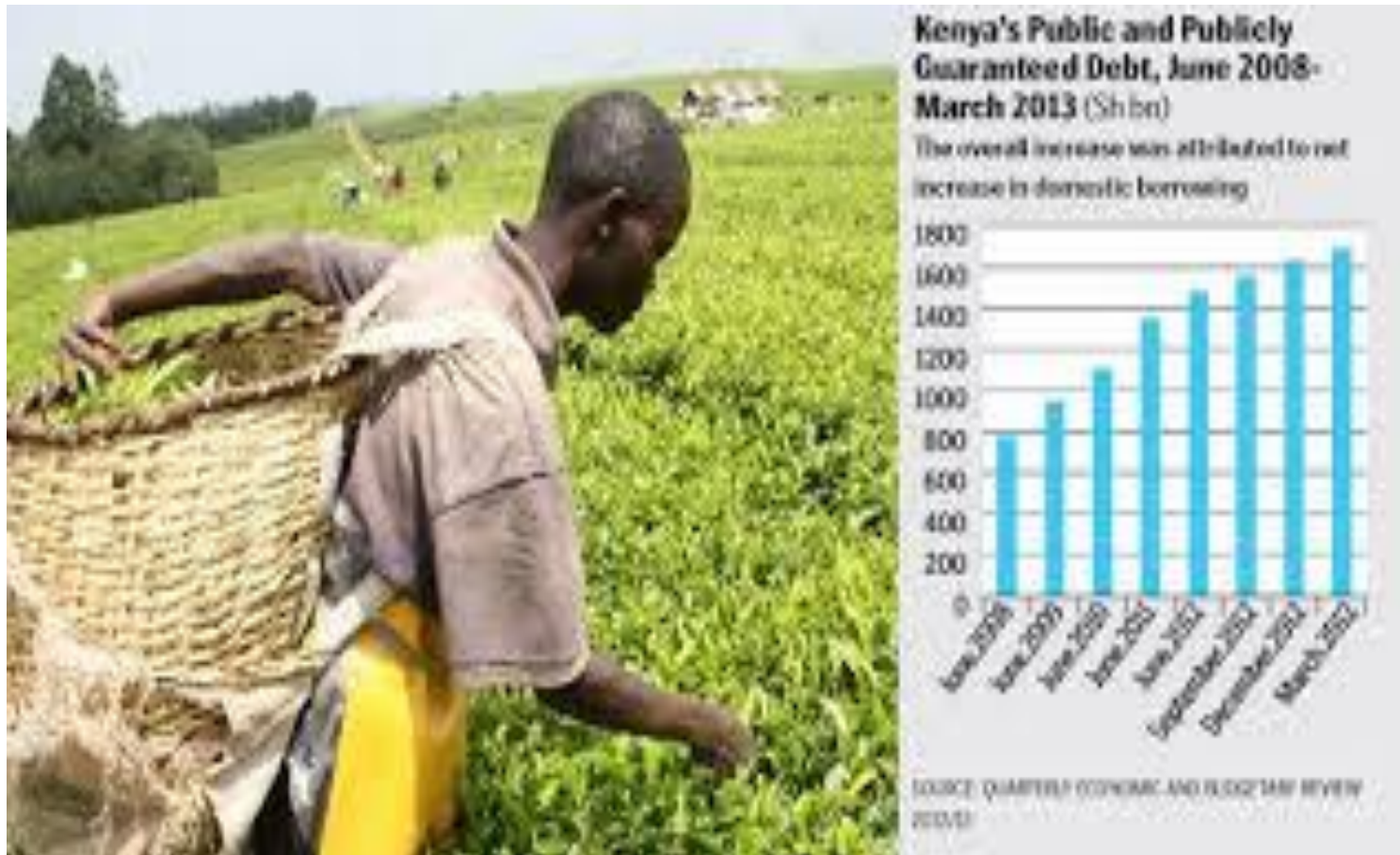


Athletics is a popular sport in Kenya. A lot of young people participate in athletics. In this picture are Kenyan athletes training in the morning.

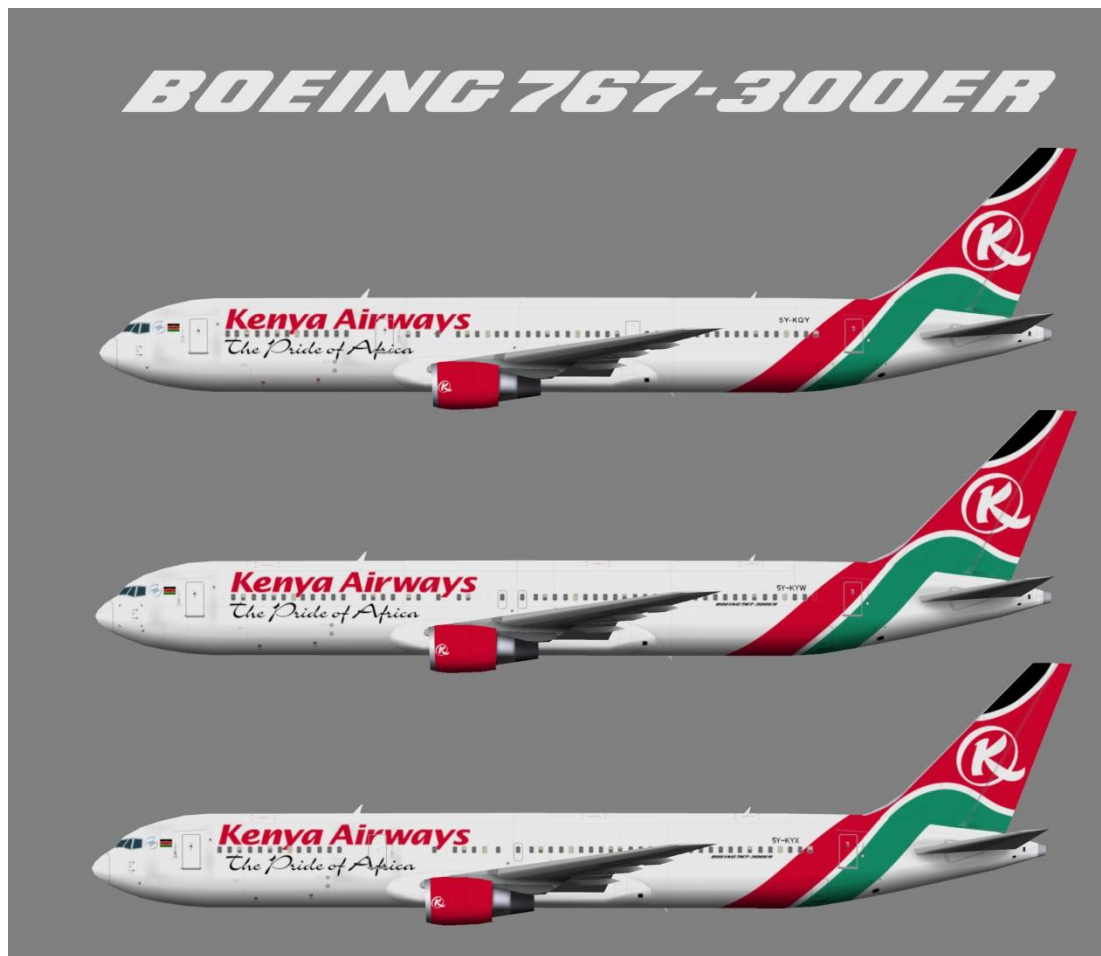

**Uhuru Muigai Kenyatta** (born 26 October 1961) is the fourth and current [President of Kenya](#), in office since 9 April 2013





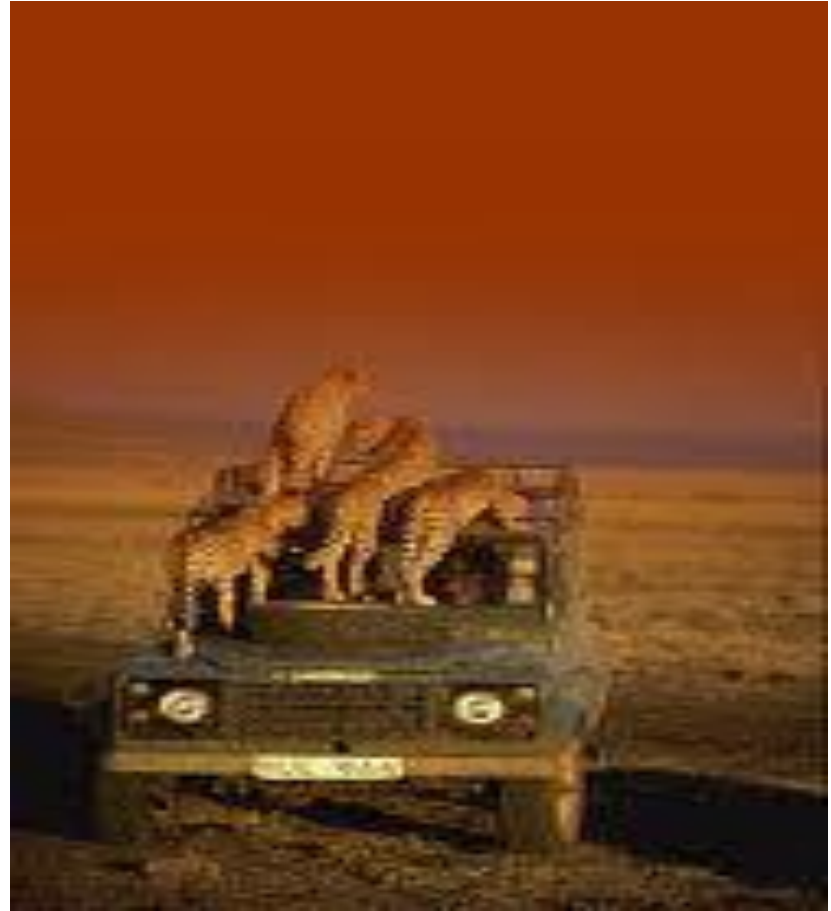

*Chapati is a popular dish in Kenya. People usually cook chapati during celebrations, happy birthdays, weddings and other big occasions.*

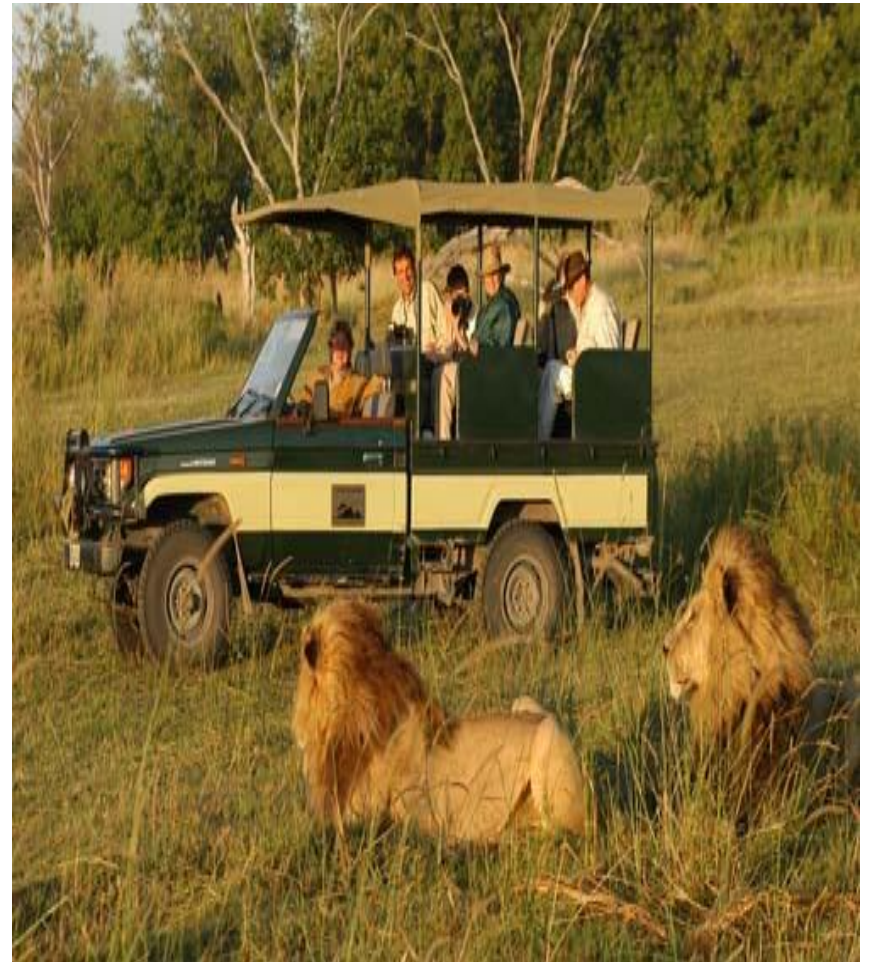


Kenya has different sports but the most popular sport is athletics.
