When it is boiled it becomes bright red.

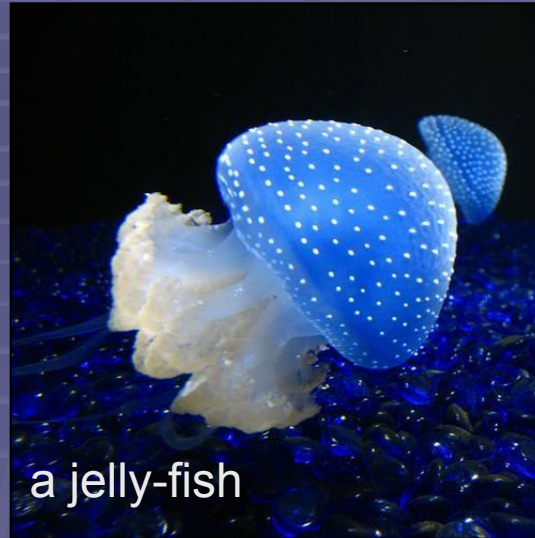
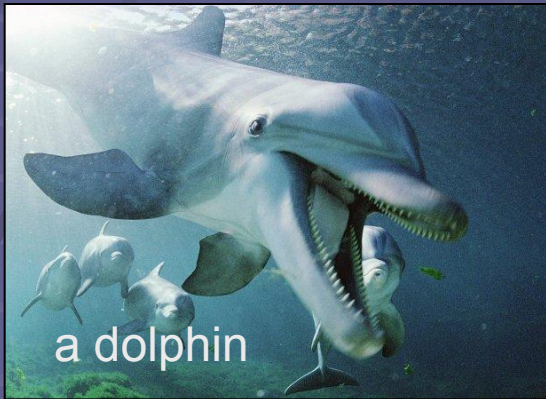
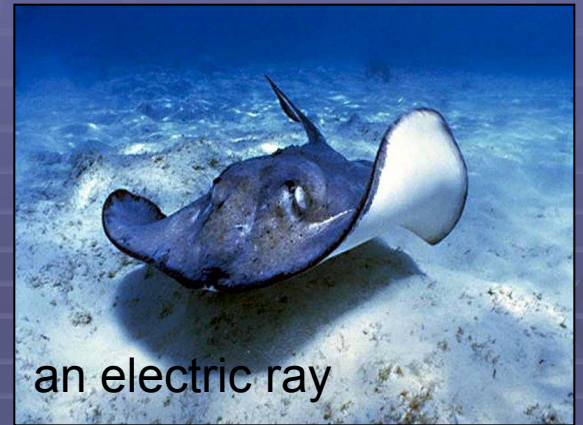
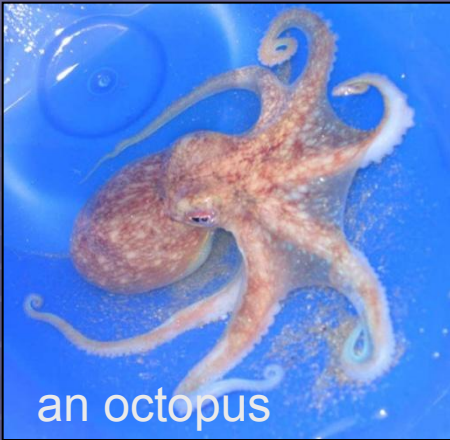

which it is going to eat.

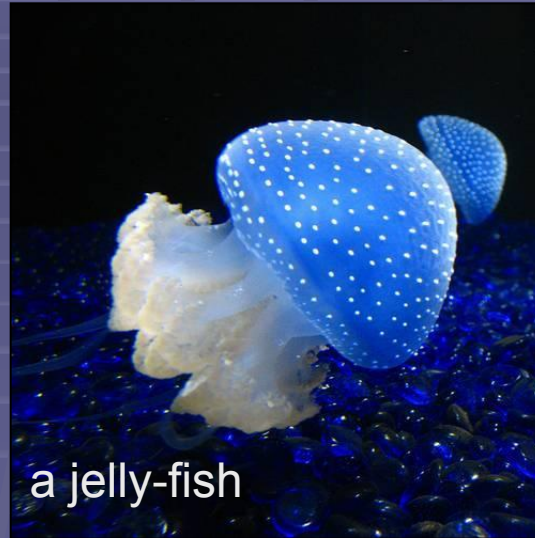
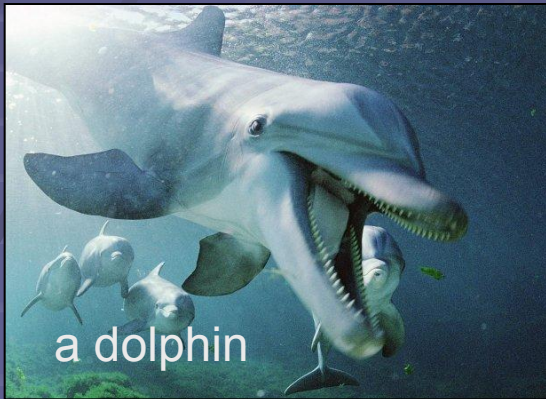
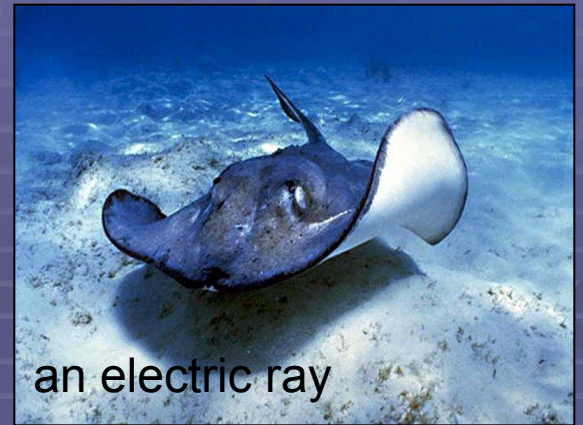

This animal was very popular and loved by people thousands of years ago in Egypt.

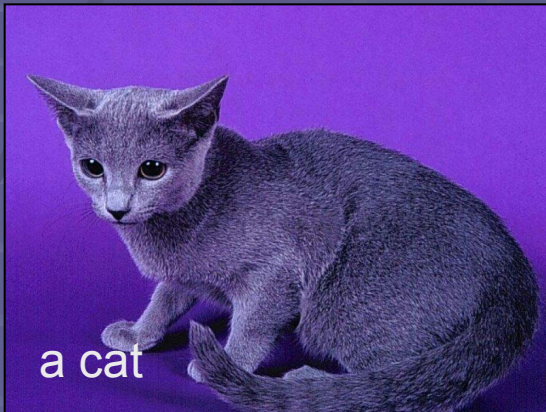

This animal can climb a tree faster than it can run on the ground.

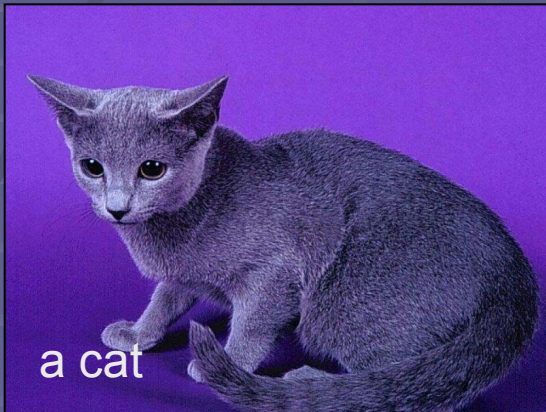

This is one of the cleverest domestic animals. These animals take much from the people whom they live with.

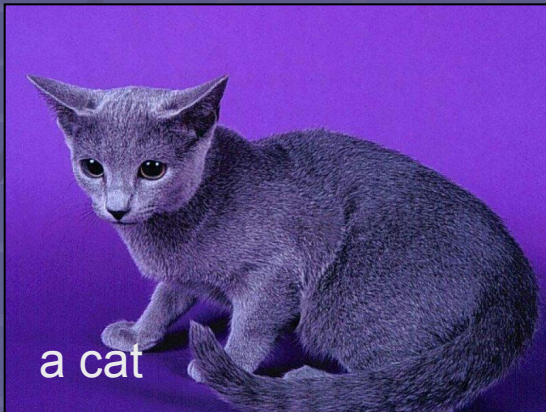

They don't consist of horn but of matted hair.



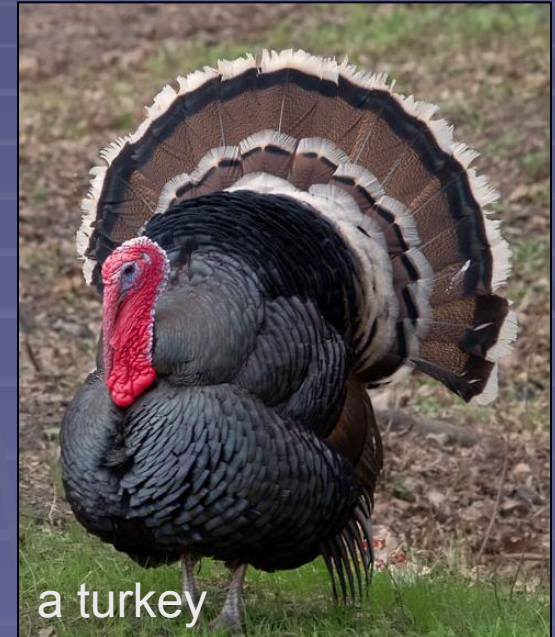
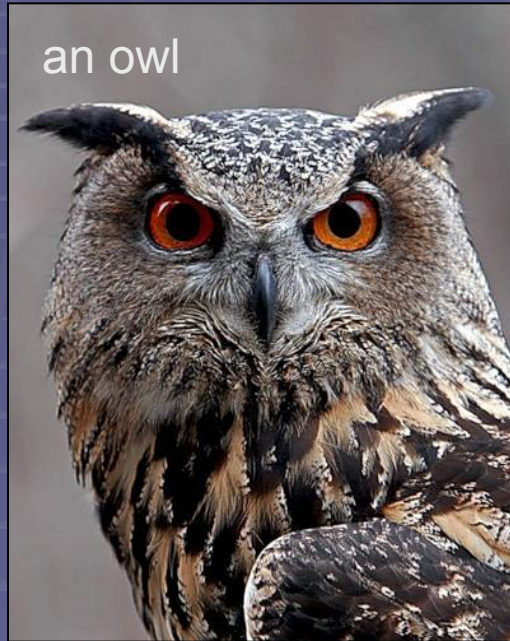

This animal runs faster than a horse and when it is born it is only one inch (2,5 cm) high.



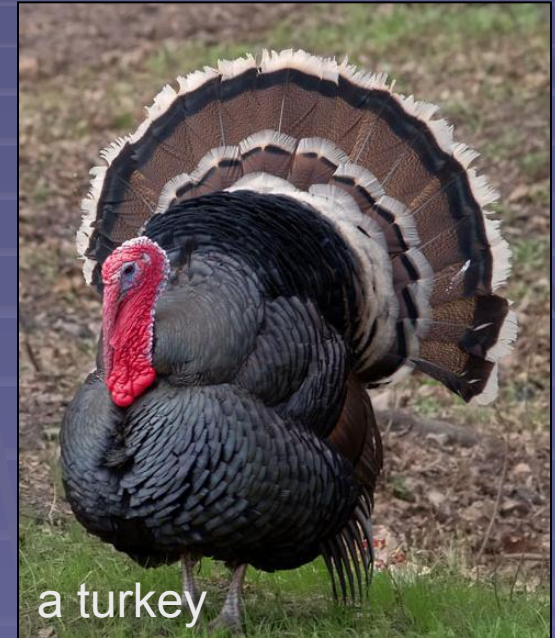
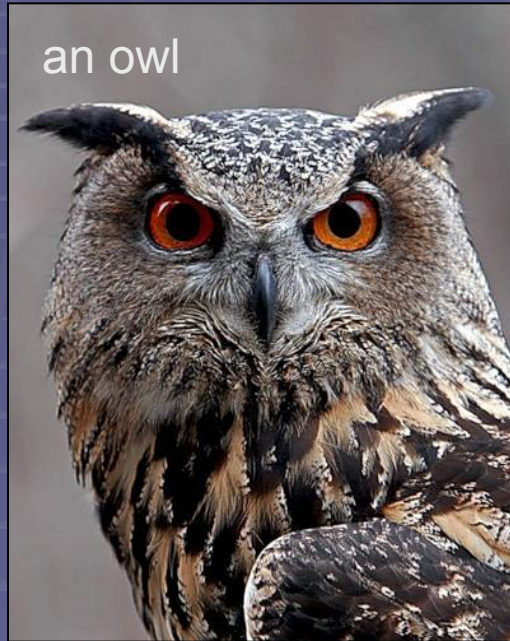

This bird cannot fly, but it can run very fast.



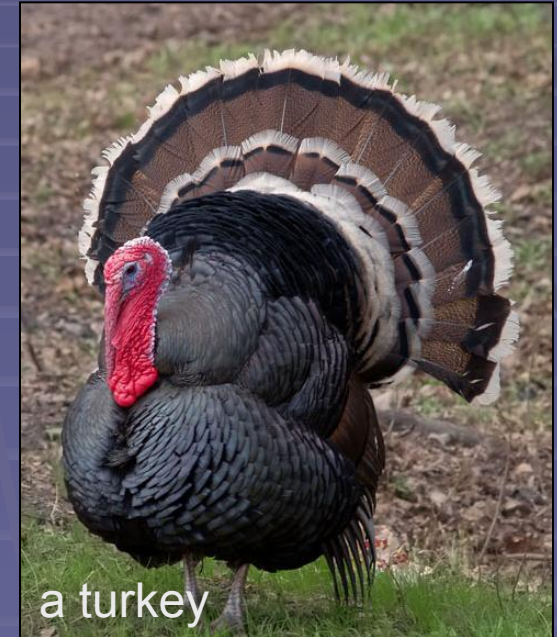
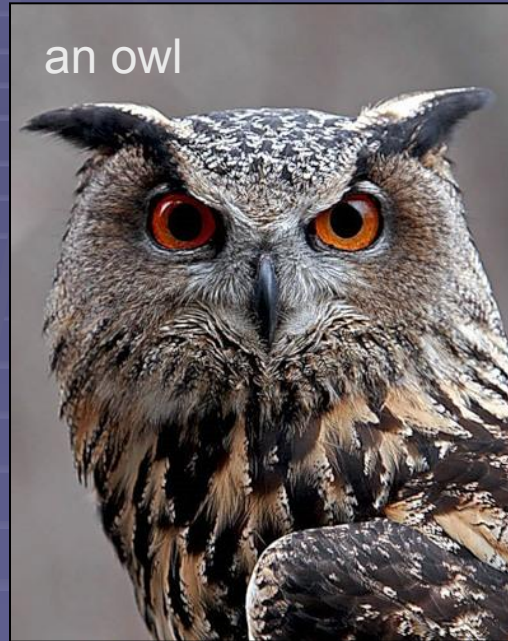

This bird can live for 100 years.



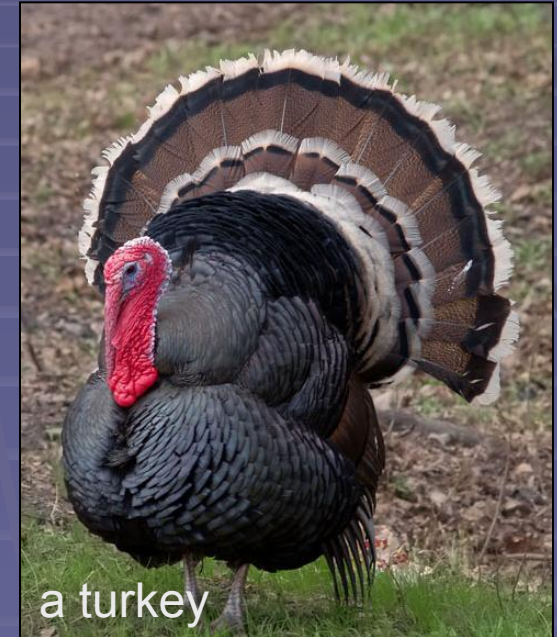

This bird can fly very quietly when it hunts. The animals can't hear it and have no time to escape.



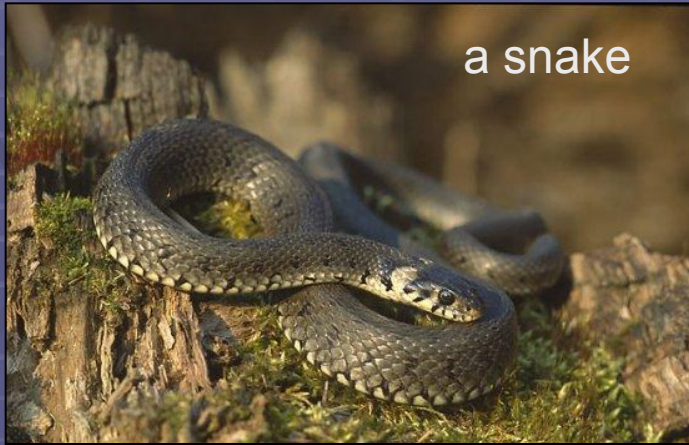
