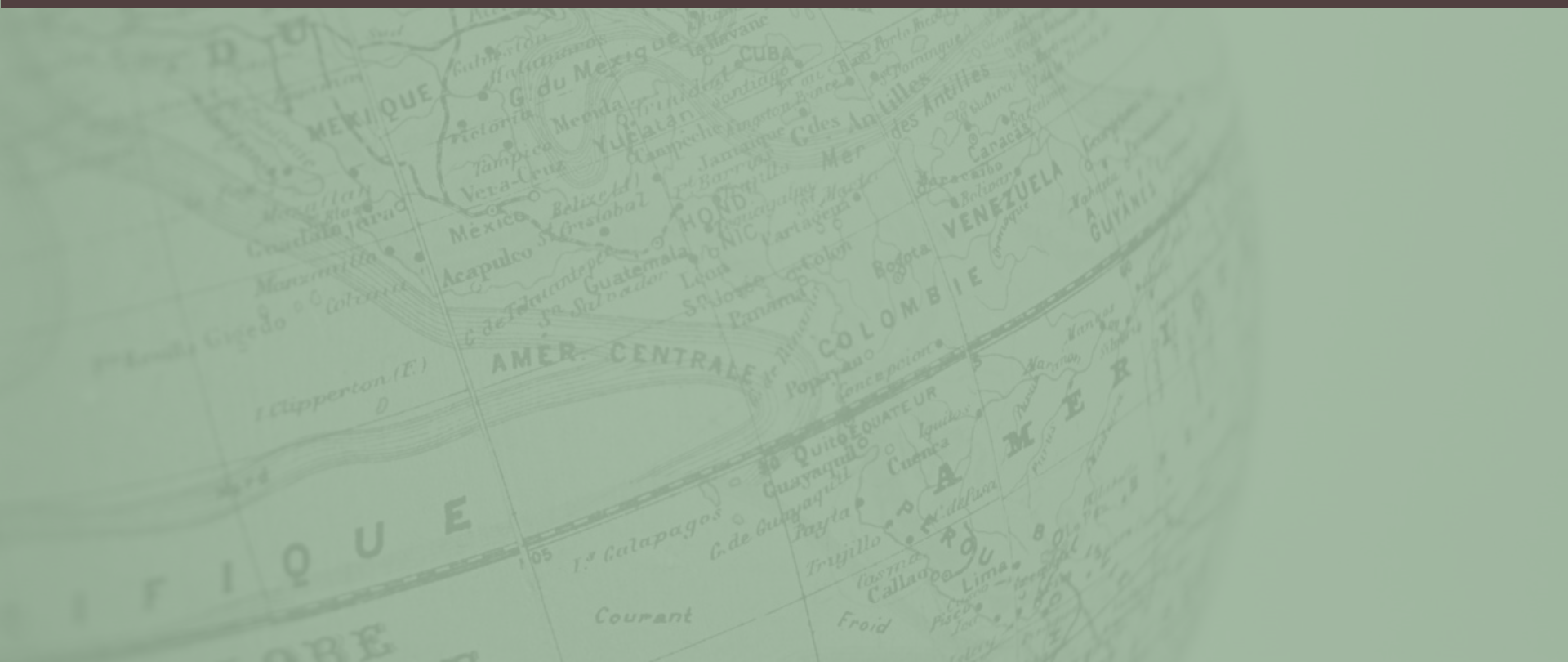

THE GREYFRIARS BOBBY MONUMENT

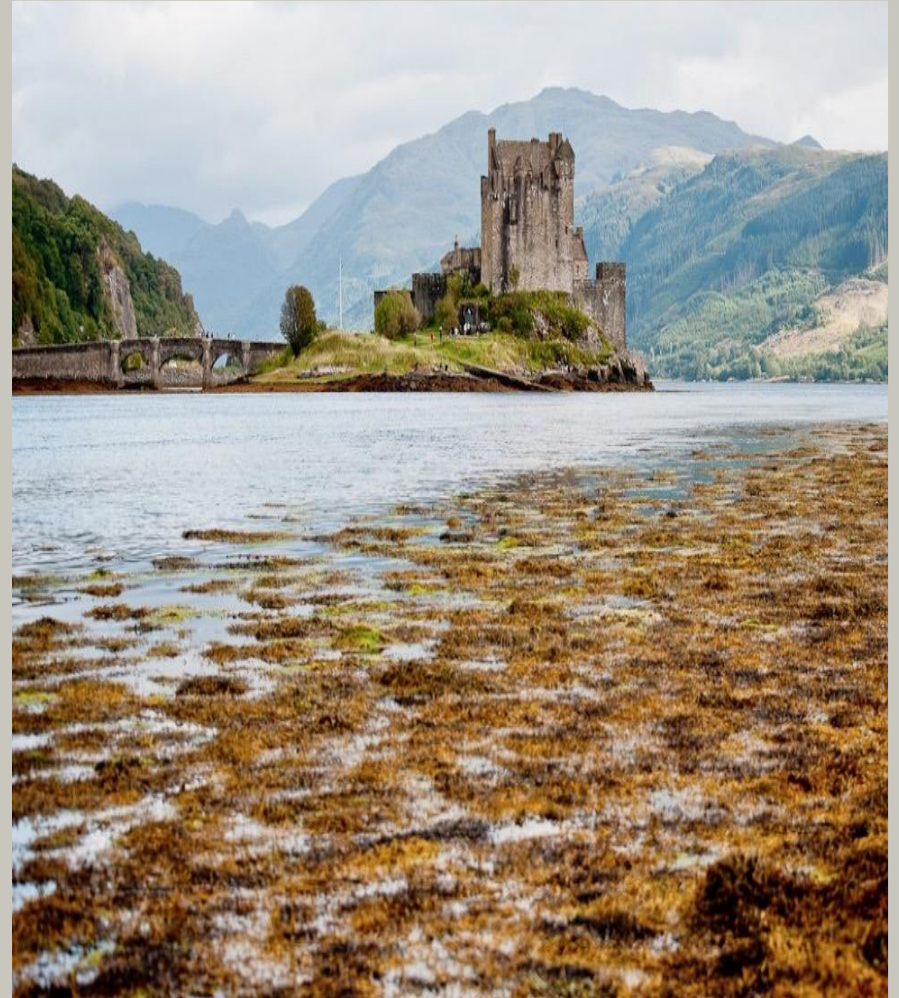
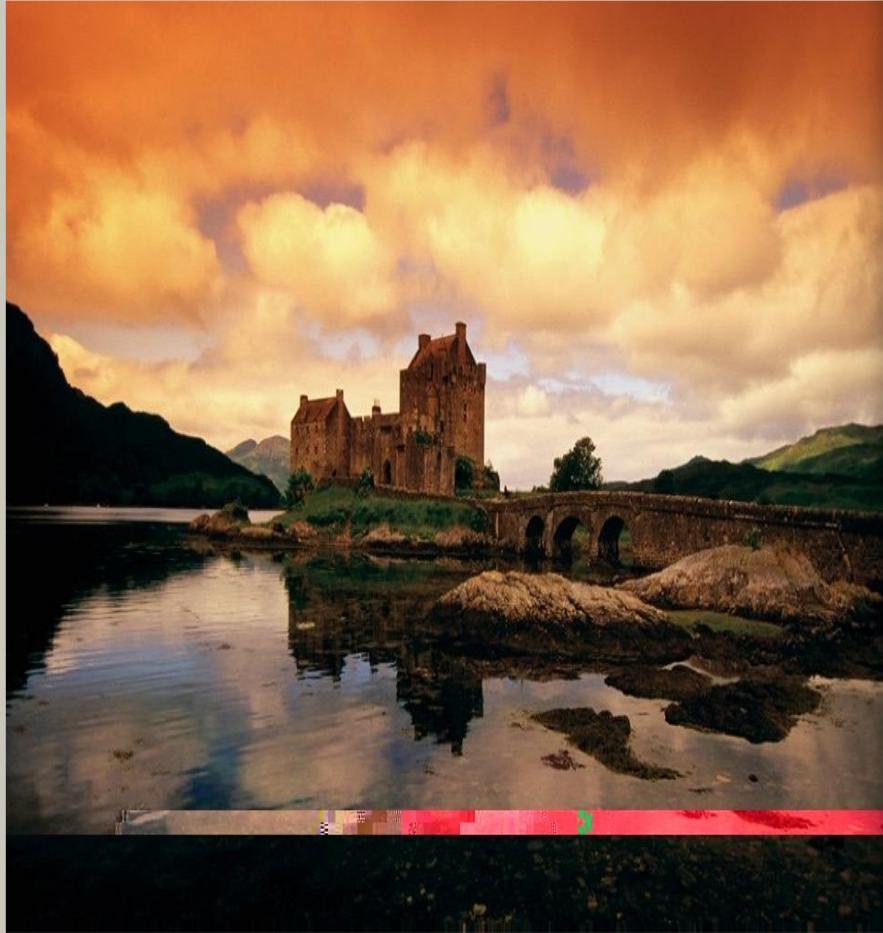
Greyfriars Bobby was a Skye Terrier who became known for supposedly spending 14 years guarding the grave of his owner until he died himself.
