**UN IN KAZAKHSTAN**

- The United Nations is an international organization founded in 1945. It is currently made up of 193 Member States.



- In 1992, April 15 by the Decree of the President of Kazakhstan was appointed the first Permanent Representative of the Republic of Kazakhstan to the United Nations (A.Arystanbekova). In 1992, June 5 the President signed a decree on the establishment of the Permanent Mission of the Republic of Kazakhstan to the United Nations.



- In 1993, February 16 a representative office was opened in Kazakhstan. Since 2010, December 12 Stephen Tull has been Resident Coordinator.



Kazakhstan is a member of almost all UN agencies, two regional commissions (UNECE and ESCAP), periodically elected a member of a number of the functional commissions of ECOSOC, as well as a member of the Executive Boards of UNICEF, UNESCO, UN-Women. From 2013 to 2015 Kazakhstan is a member of the Human Rights Council of the UN.
