History of the flag.



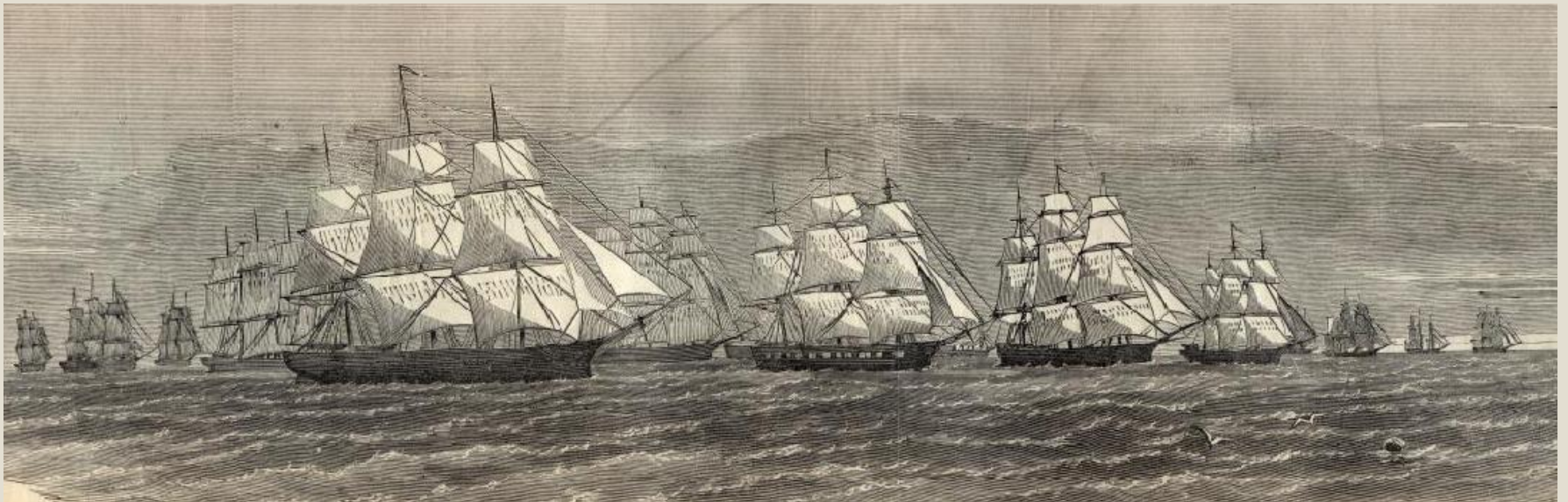

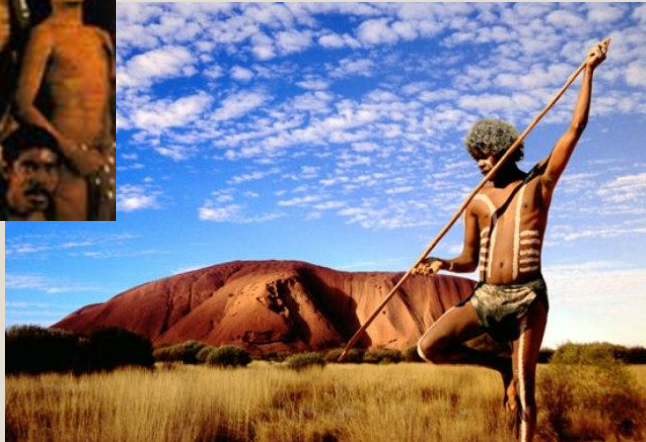
- The first people in Australia were the Aborigines , who came more 40,000 years ago
