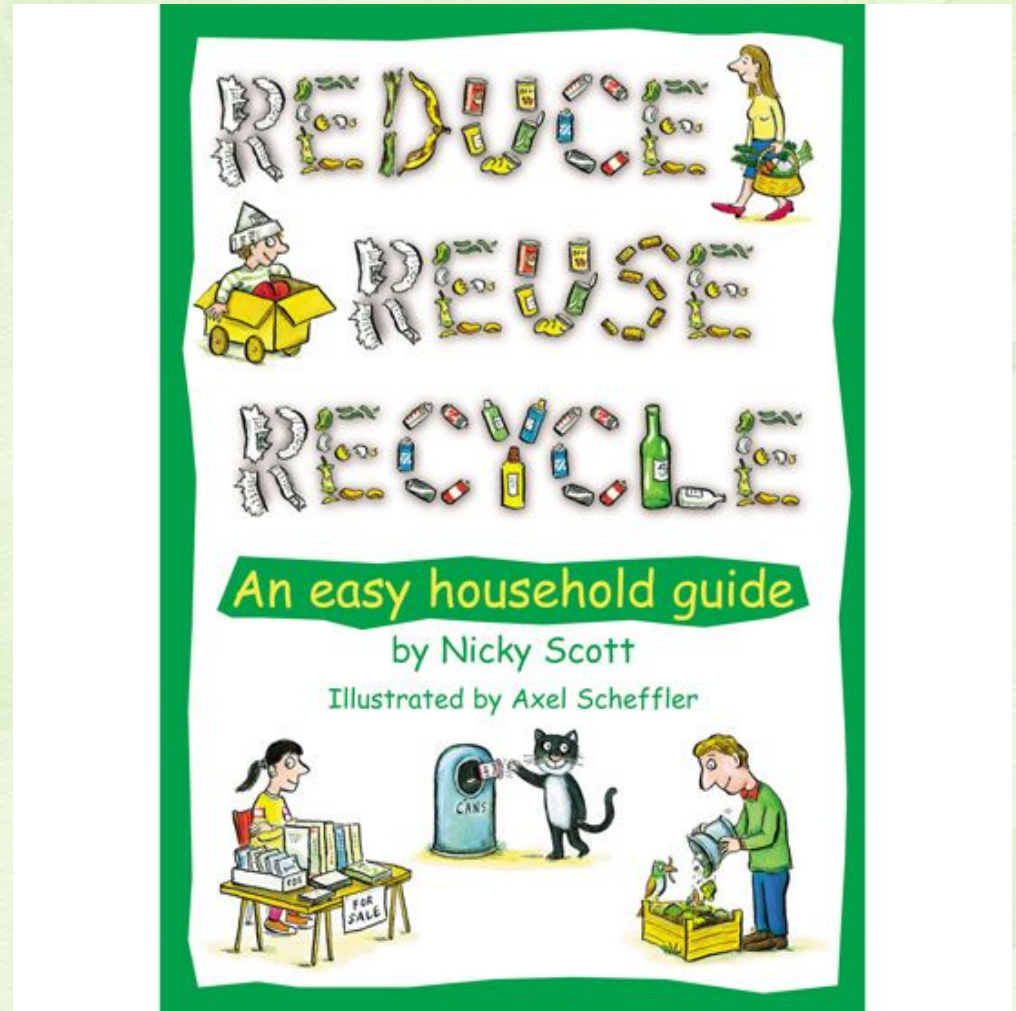

Resources Conservation

- Throwing away a single aluminum can, versus recycling it, is like pouring out six ounces of gasoline.
- Last year, Americans recycled enough aluminum cans to conserve the energy equivalent to more than **15 million barrels of oil.**



1 million tons of steel recycled saves...

- 1.3 million tons of iron ore
- 718,000 tons of coal
- 62,000 tons of limestone.

It requires more energy to
manufacture a brand new
aluminum can than it
does to recycle 20
aluminum cans.
