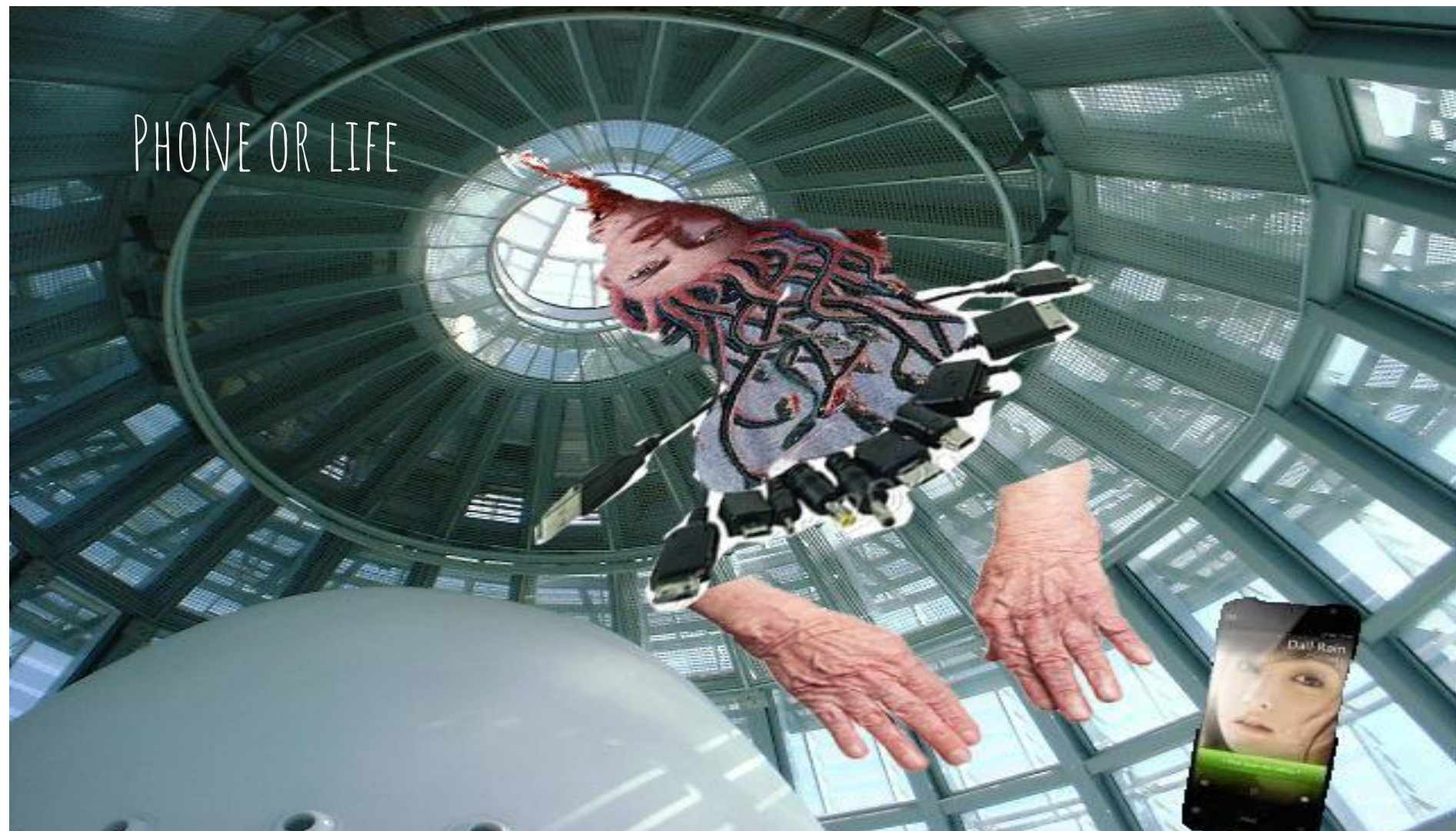




THE EXHIBITION

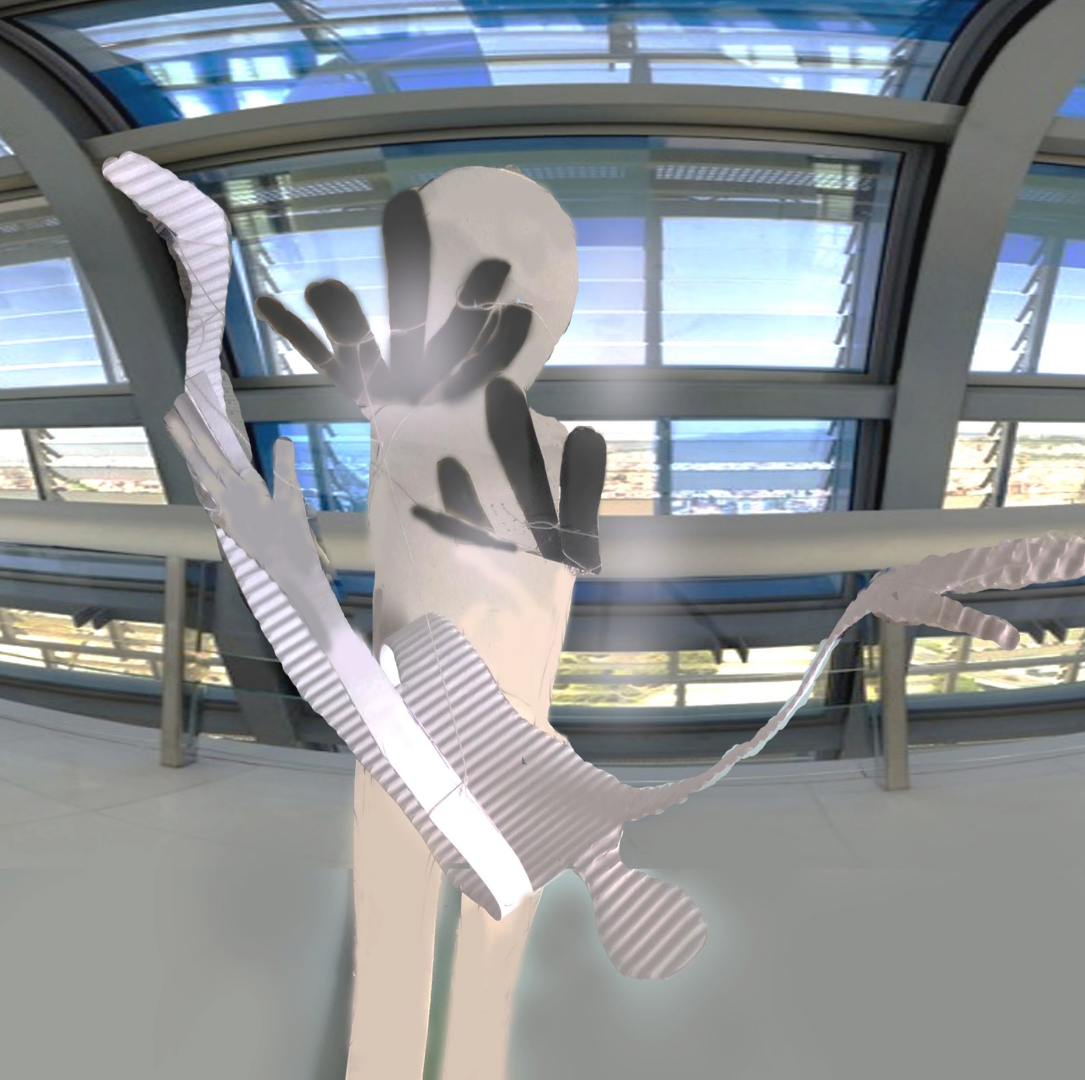

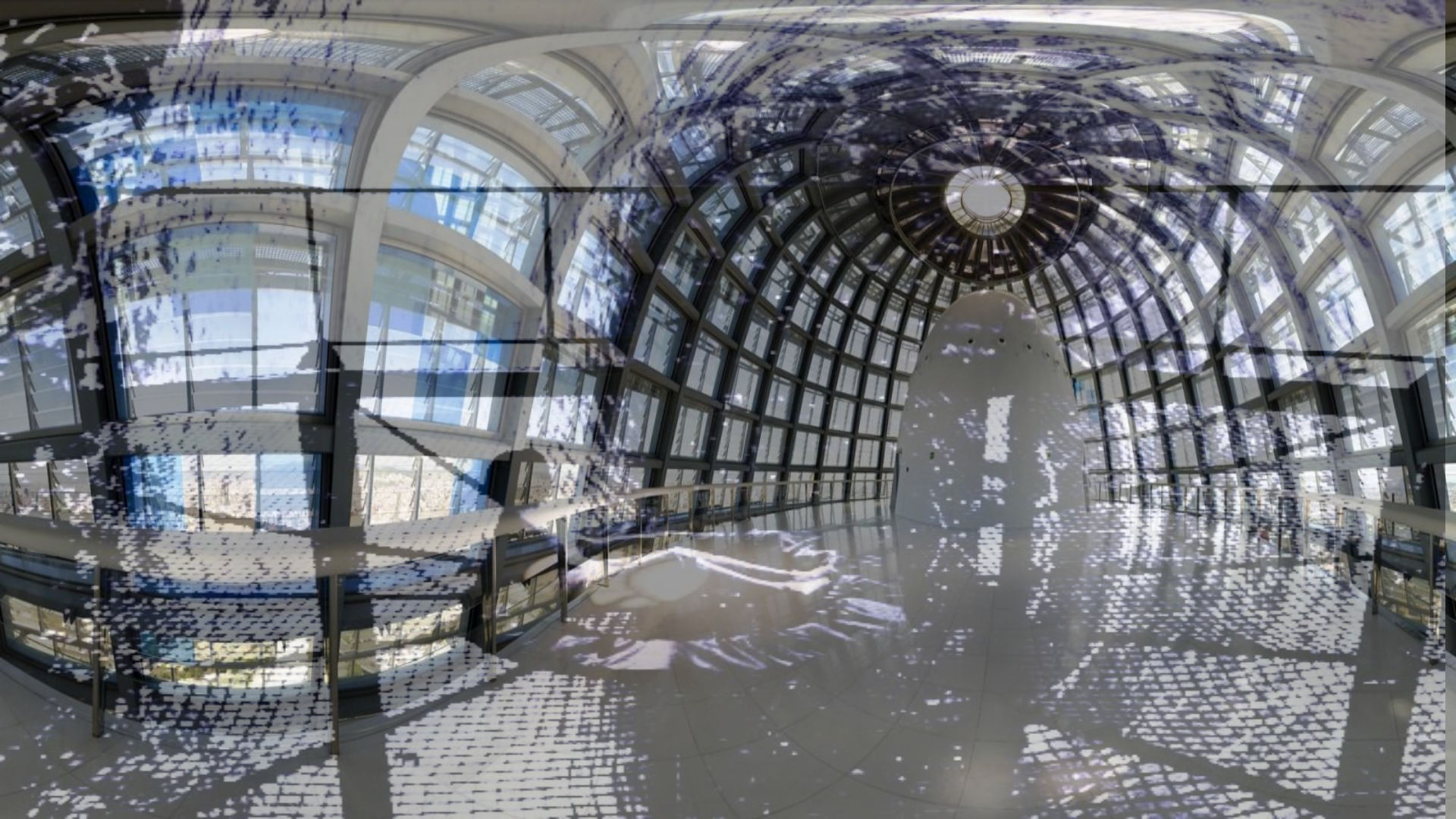
