HALLOWEEN IN FRANCE

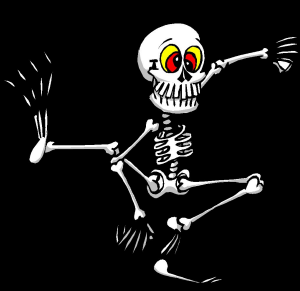
