Someone capable of coming up with original ideas.

Organized

Arranged or structured in a systematic way.

Experienced

Having knowledge or skill in a job or activity.

Methodical

Doing things according to an established procedure.

Responsible

Answering for something that you have control over.

Reliable

Someone who can be trusted to get something done.

Insightful

Showing a deep understanding of something.

Articulate

Ability to speak intelligently; easy to understand.

Resourceful

Solving problems and making decisions on your own.

Proactive

Taking action to control a situation.
