


• After gaining independence, the Republic of Belarus in 1991, we did not have their bills. The first "settlement Tickets» Belarus appeared only in 1992. The smallest denomination Belarus (if they can be called so, because "our money" is strikingly different from the 'normal' bills) ... was the nominal value of 50 cents.
