## Negative with 'be'

I **was** not sleepy.

You **were** not on the bus.

He **was** not at school.

He **was** not ugly.

It **was** not hot.

We **were** not at work.

They **were** not tired.

## Negative Short Form

I **wasn't** sleepy.

You **weren't** on the bus.

He **wasn't** at school.

He **wasn't** ugly.

It **wasn't** hot.

We **weren't** at work.

They **weren't** tired.

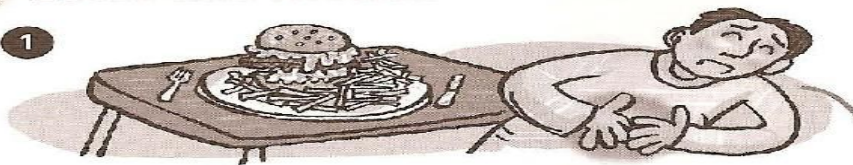

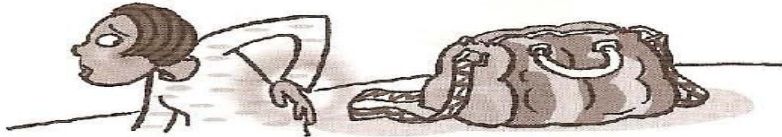

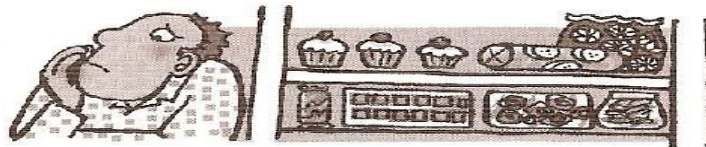
