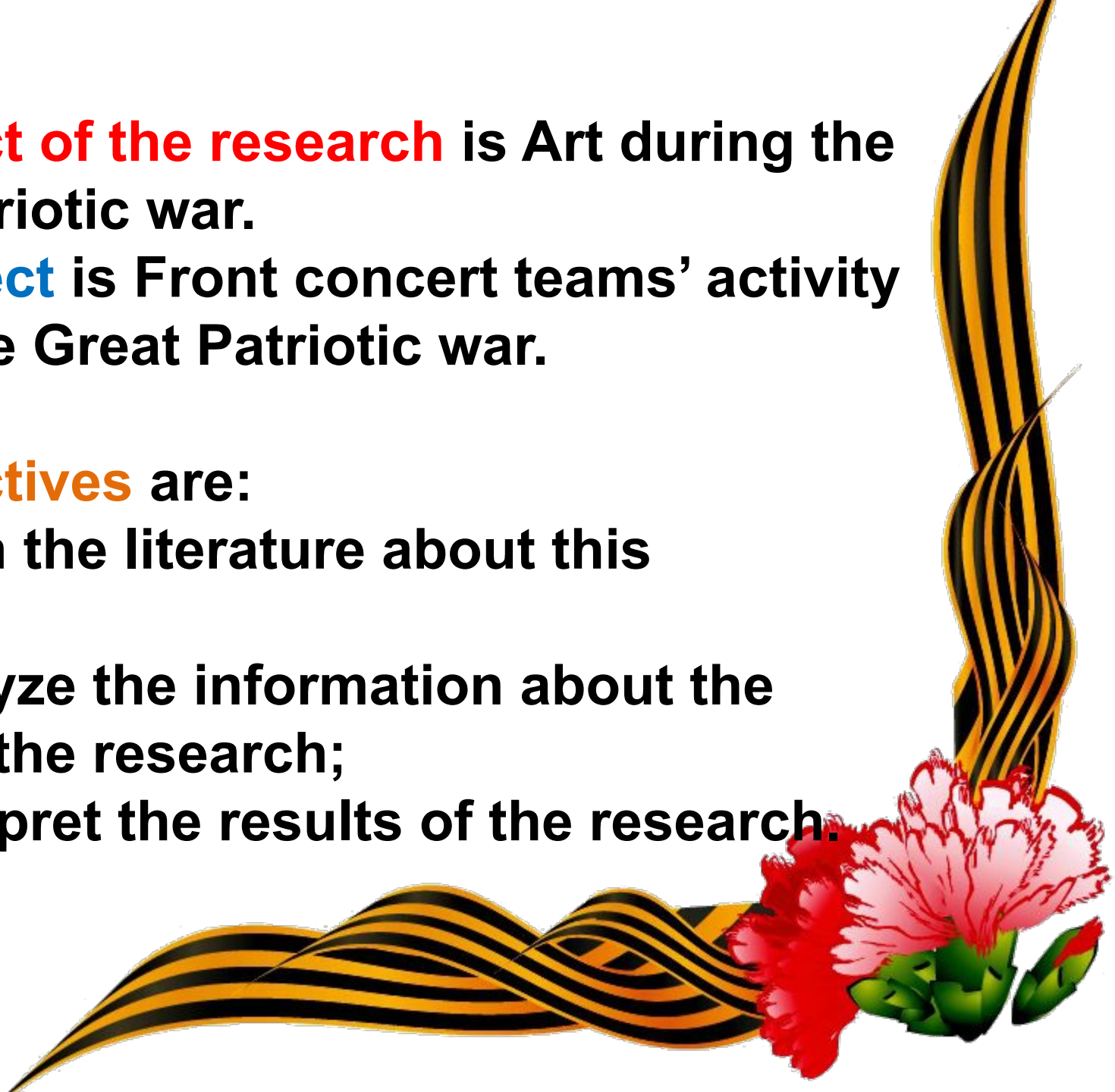



The object of the research is Art during the Great Patriotic war.

The objectives are:

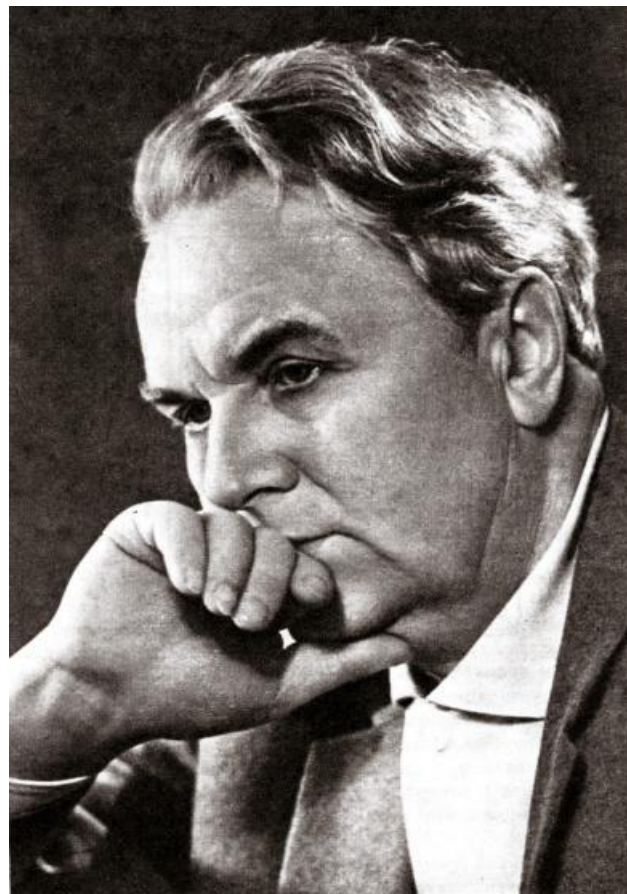
1. to learn the literature about this problem;

**The Plenum of the Central Committee of
the Union of actors published the
«Appeal to all creative workers»
on June 23, 1941:**

**«Wherever there are parts of our Red
army and Navy, art workers share with
the soldiers the war life. Now our art is
powerful means of the victory of
communism over fascism.»**





During the Great Patriotic war, Leonid Utyosov, with his jazz band, gave more than 200 concerts on different fronts. They worked in the hardest conditions, were bombed out a dozen times.

Izabella Yurieva. Only in the besieged Leningrad she gave 106 concerts, getting there on the Road of Life. In winter, when it was 38 degrees of cold, she sang on the Karelian and Kalininsky fronts. Without a microphone.

In total during the Great Patriotic war about four thousand front concert teams were organized, from them more than 700 were organized in Moscow and more than 500 were organized in Leningrad.



1941-1945

The Director of the Moscow art theatre, Joseph Moisseychovich Rayevsky described the Soviet soldiers: **“We appealed to ordinary spectators, who had been separated from families, from their business and had been forced to take up arms. At the same time, these viewers were extraordinary! It was necessary to show them high art, telling them about the triumph of life, truth, justice.”**





Among the active participants of the front concert teams the greatest actors were: Lyubov Orlova, Nina Ruslanova, Arkadii Raikin, Leonid Utyossov, Alla Tarasova and others.

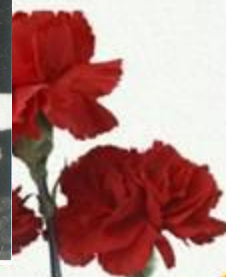

Claudia Shulzhenko. During the first year of the Leningrad blockade she gave 500 concerts, she went to the front hundreds of times. In 1942 she was awarded with the medal "For the Defense of Leningrad", and May 9, 1945 – the order of the Red Star.





In total, 1 million 350 thousand performances and concerts were played. 42,000 actors took part in the concerts, some of them performed on various fronts several hundred times.



**The role and contribution of front

were awarded with orders and medals
of the Soviet Union.**
