What is travel?

Travel – the movement of people from one place to another using different types of transport – by air, rail, road or sea

What is tourism?

- The World Tourism Organisation (WTO) defines tourism as: '...the activities of persons travelling to and staying in places outside their usual environment for not more than one consecutive year for leisure, business or other purposes'.

What is travel? What is tourism?

Travel – the movement of people from one place to another using different types of transport

Tourism – the provision of services to tourists

Everything that tourists do while they are away is considered part of the travel and tourism industry.

People who travel

 All types of travellers engaged in tourism are described as visitors.

- Visitors can be distinguished as:
- Tourists: visitors who stay away from home for at least 24 hours
- Day visitors: visitors who do not stay overnight




- Inbound tourists

Inbound tourists

Those coming into to visit a country which is not their country of residence








Outbound tourists

Outbound tourism – undertaken by visitors travelling outside their own country



Domestic Tourists?

- Domestic tourists
- Visitors travelling within their own country for tourism purposes.
