- Представляю вашему вниманию популярную , всем известную игру «Кто хочет стать миллионером», адаптированную для среднеобразовательной школы.
- Этот вариант рассчитан на участие нескольких команд. Таким образом, все учащиеся вовлечены в игру.
- Игра рассчитана на учащихся 7 классов.
- В игре использован аутентичный материал из книг о Гарри Поттере и фото из фильма «Гарри Поттер и философский камень».

Цели игры:

Развивать навыки учащихся по теме «Условные предложения 0 и 1 типов» на основе аутентичного материала (Книги о Гарри Поттере).

Правила игры:

- Учащиеся делятся на 4 команды, соответственно факультетам школы Хогвартс.
- Каждая команда получает карточки с буквами “G”, “S”, “H”, “R”
- Учащиеся должны ответить на все вопросы и «совершить побег» из волшебного банка Гринготтс, прихватив 1 млн. До сих пор выбраться из банка удалось только золотому трио.
- Ведущий распределяет очередность участия команд в игре.
- Зачитав вопрос, команды совещаются в течение 15 секунд и поднимают карточку с буквой предполагаемого ответа.
- Если команда отвечает на вопрос правильно, то она получает соответствующую сумму. Если неправильно – 0.
- Команда, набравшая больше «денег» из «Гринготтс», выигрывает.

Примечание: в игре есть возможность использовать подсказку 50:50. Для этого необходимо нажать на соответствующую иконку на слайде.
