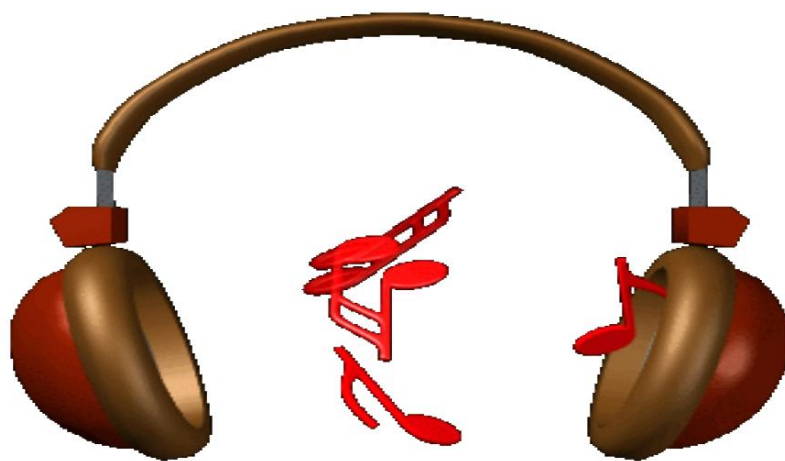

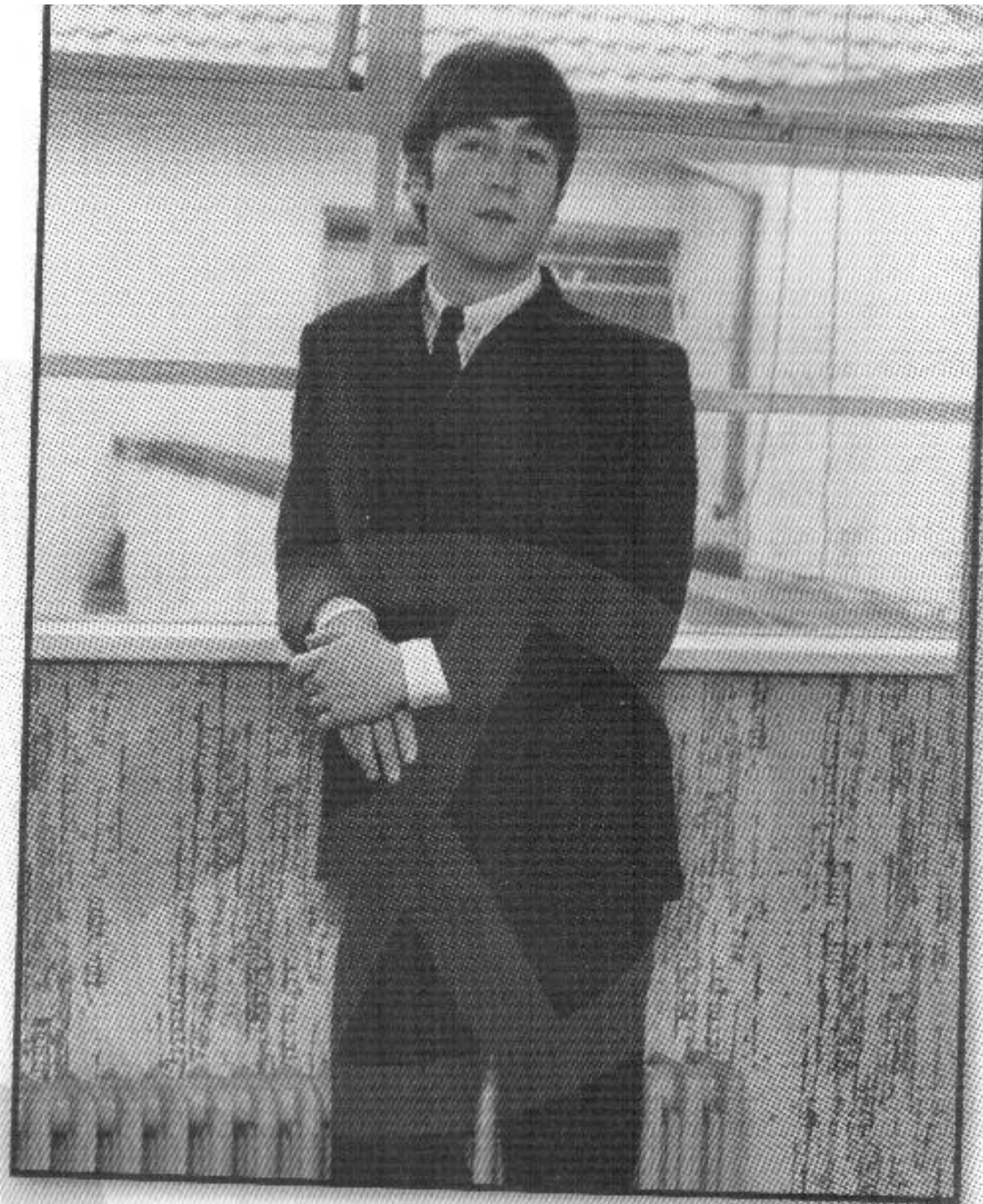

John Lennon was born in 1940 in Liverpool, England. When John was five, his father left the family so he went to live with his Aunt Mimi and Uncle George. John saw his mother sometimes and she taught him to play the banjo. When he was a teenager, Aunt Mimi bought him a guitar. Sadly, the year after John Lennon left high school, his mother died in a car accident outside Aunt Mimi's house.

Soon after his mother died, John made friends with Paul McCartney. They both played the guitar and they started to write songs together. They decided to start a band with another guitarist and a drummer and The Beatles were born.







In the 1960s, The Beatles were the most famous band in the world. Young people copied their clothes and hairstyles to look like them. John and Paul wrote the band's songs and they sold millions of records. The Beatles also starred in some very successful movies.

In 1970 the band split up and John moved to the United States with his second wife, Yoko Ono. They became peace activists because they wanted to stop wars.

Then, in 1980, a man called Mark Chapman murdered John Lennon outside his apartment in New York. His death shocked millions of people all over the world.
