# Every

Every is another word for all.

- Everyone = all people
- Everybody = all people
- Everything = all things

Everybody = Everyone

#### No-

 No- as a indefinite pronoun means not any.

- No one / Nobody= Not any person.
- Nothing = Not any thing.

# Any

 Used to refer to one or some of a thing or number of things, no matter how much or many.

- Anyone / Anybody = one or some people.
- Anything = one or some things.

#### Some

An unspecified amount or number of.
 (Unspecified = not stated clearly or exactly.)

- Someone / Somebody = unspecified amount or number of people.
- Something = unspecified amount or number of things.

#### Affirmative

- Someone / Somebody / Something
- No one / Nobody / Nothing
- □ Everyone / Everybody/ Everything
- ✓ Someone sent me a picture.
- Something is beeping.
- ✓ No one came to the party.
- Nothing is in the room.
- Everyone came to the party.
- Everything is ready.

### Negative

- Someone / Somebody / Something
- Anyone / Anybody / Anything

- ✓ Someone didn't listen to the teacher.
- Something isn't right.
- ✓ I don't think anyone is going to go to the party.
- I can't hear anything.

### Yes / No Question

- Anyone / Anybody / Anything
- □ Everyone / Everybody / Everything
- Someone / Something
- ✓ Is anyone going to go to school?
- ✓ Is everyone ready to go?
- Can you see anything?
- ✓ Did anyone call you last night?
- Did everything go as it was planned?
- ✓ Is someone coming?
- ✓ Is there something to eat?
