Gaston Leroux (1868-1927)

Was born in Paris He studied law and graduated in 1889. He worked as a court reporter, theatre critic and journalist. He began writing fiction in 1907. Leroux is best known for The Phantom of the Opera (1910)/. The novel was translated into English in 1911 and has been made into several films.



In 1986 Andrew Lloyd Webber, the famous English composer, made a brilliant musical "The Phantom of the Opera" which had a great success. Music compositions from this musicals became hits and won many awards

The most famous adaptation of the novel was made in 2004 by Joel Shumacher with Gerard Butler and Emmy Rossum in the leading roles
