




Films are set in high school




'Ferris Bueller's Day Off'

- ✓ became one of the top-grossing films of the year.




'She's All That'




- ✓ American teen romantic comedy film directed by Robert Iscove in 1999;
- ✓ a high school big man Zack makes a bet with his friends that he can turn an unattractive girl Laney into the school's prom queen;
- ✓ was one of the most popular teen films of the 1990s and reached No 1 at the box office in its first week of release.

'10 Things I Hate About You'

- ✓ American romantic comedy film directed by Gil Junger in 1999;
- ✓ new student Cameron is smitten with Bianca and, in order to get around her father's strict rules on dating, attempts to get "bad boy" Patrick to date Bianca's sister, Kat;
- ✓ was No 2 at the domestic box office during its opening weekend, behind only 'The Matrix'.




‘The Perks of Being A Wallflower’




- ✓ American coming-of-age, comedy-drama film, based on the best-selling novel by Stephen Chbosky, directed by him in 2012;

- ✓ American romantic comedy-drama film that based on the novel of the same name by Tim Tharp, directed by James Ponsoldt in 2013;
