The first house is small.

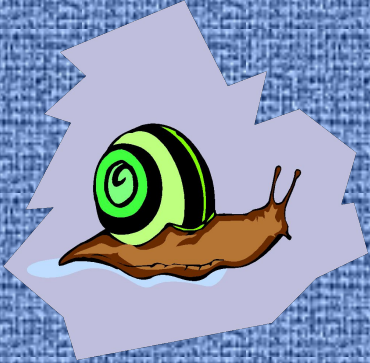
