
- Formed in 2013

- Staging clips / choreography





- 1 album | 2 Extended Plays



Rock music

Korea

- → heavy American influence in 1954
- → not "mainstream"
- → Usually lyrics about romance
- → Have Music Videos
- \rightarrow Rock ballad are popular
- \rightarrow Take care of their appearance

Russia

- → became known in the Soviet
 Union in the 1960s
- → not "mainstream"
- → Lyrics about national themes, politics
- → Partly Folk rock
- \rightarrow Doesn't care about appearance

Old rock music

YB (Yoon Do-hyun Band), 윤도현밴드

- Formed in 1996
- influenced by classic rock with elements of modern ro
- explosive and dynamic live performances

Kino, (Russian: Кино)

- formed in Leningrad in 1982
- one of the first Russian rock bands
- Tsoi in particular is a cult hero (Tsoi is alive)



A BRIEF HISTORY OF THAI ROCK

1980S

The Thai rock genre began by Laem Morrison who performed for American soldiers during the Vietnam war.



Heavy metal emerged, with bands such as Stone Metal Fire, Kaleidoscope, Donpheebin, Big Gun and Hi-Rock. A popular Thai rock singer at that time was Itti Palangkul and Chatchai Sukkhawadee (Rang Rockestra)



In the 1990s, alternative and indie music in Thailand was established, following the breakthrough of the American band Nirvana, whose success widely popularized alternative rock in the early-1990s. Several alt-rock bands sprung up, such as Moderndog, Silly Fools, Y Not 7, Sepia, Labanoon and Crub.



In the 2000s, Clash released their first album, "ONE". Their first single, "Gaud (Hug)" was a big hit, and led the band to success.

- Present: 'Shape of you'


