The Present, Past and Future Continuous tenses

Continuous

- Present continuous
- Past continuous
- Future continuous

Present continuous

is composed of two parts—the present tense of the verb to be (am; is ; are)

the present participle of the main verb (V-ing).

Present Continuous expresses the action which is happening at the moment of speech. E.g. **Every student is**

They are talking to each other.

The sun is shining.

I am playing a computer.

He is singing.

Present Continuous

has also the meaning of **futurity** when the action is planned beforehand.

 $hp + \sqrt{-1}\eta$

e.g. Alex and Rose are getting married next month; they have invited all guests.

Past continuous

is composed of two parts : the past tense of the verb to be (was / were) and the base of the main verb +ing (V-ing).

Past Continuous expresses the action which was happening at a specific time in the past. E.g. **Every student was** running yesterday in the afternoon.

was/

were



They were talking to each other yesterday.

I was playing a computer yesterday.

He was singing yesterday.

The sun was shining yesterday.

Future continuous

is made up of two elements : the simple future of the verb 'to be' -will be

the present participle of the verb-Ving.

Future Continuous expresses the action which will be happening at a specific time in the future. **Every student will be** running tomorrow in the afternoon.

Will be

Future continuous They will be talking to each other tomorrow. The sun will be shining tomorrow. I will be playing a computer tomorrow. **He will be singing tomorrow.**
