

### Fine Arts


Fine art - (also fine arts) describes an <u>art</u> form developed primarily for <u>aesthetics</u> and concept rather than practical application. Forms of art, especially painting, drawing and sculpture, that are created to be beautiful rather than useful Fine art comprises: drawing, culinary art, architecture, painting, literature, sculpture and new media art



Drawing is a mean of making an image, using any of a wide variety of tools and techniques



<u>Culinary art</u> is the <u>art</u> of preparing and <u>cooking</u> food.



Architecture is the art and science of designing buildings and structures.



#### <u>Painting</u> is the act or art of using paint to produce pictures

<u>Sculpture</u> is three-dimensional artwork created by shaping or combining hard materials typically stone - or marble, metal, glass, or wood. Softer ("plastic") materials can also be used, such as <u>clay</u>, <u>textiles</u>, plastics, polymers and softer metals.



<u>New media art</u> is a genre that includes artworks created with new media technologies, including digital art, computer graphics, **computer** animation compute r animation, virtual art, Internet art.



<u>Performing arts</u> are the arts which are performed for the audience

Performing arts include <u>acrobatics</u>, <u>comedy</u>, <u>dance</u>, <u>magic</u>, <u>music</u>, <u>opera</u>, <u>operetta</u>, <u>film</u>, <u>juggling</u>, <u>martial arts</u>, and <u>theatre</u>.

### Applied Arts

Applied art is the application of <u>design</u> and <u>aesthetics</u> to objects of <u>function</u> <u>and</u> <u>everyday use</u>.

Whereas <u>fine arts</u> serve as <u>intellectual</u> <u>stimulation</u> to the viewer or academic sensibilities, the applied arts incorporate design and creative ideals to <u>objects of</u> <u>utility</u>, such as a cup, magazine or decorative park bench.

### **Applied** Arts

The fields of <u>industrial design</u>, <u>graphic</u> <u>design</u>, <u>fashion design</u>, <u>interior design</u>, decorative art and <u>functional</u> (modern architecture) art are considered applied arts.

Many applied art objects are <u>collected</u>, for instance ceramics, textiles, jewelry, glass, furniture, children's toys, cars, electric guitars, as well as various forms of images produced in commercial contexts, such as film posters or old advertisements.
