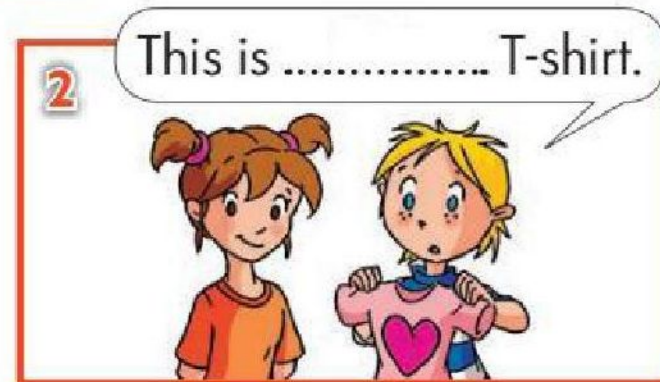
## Grammar corner

This is my fish.      That's its head, not its tail.

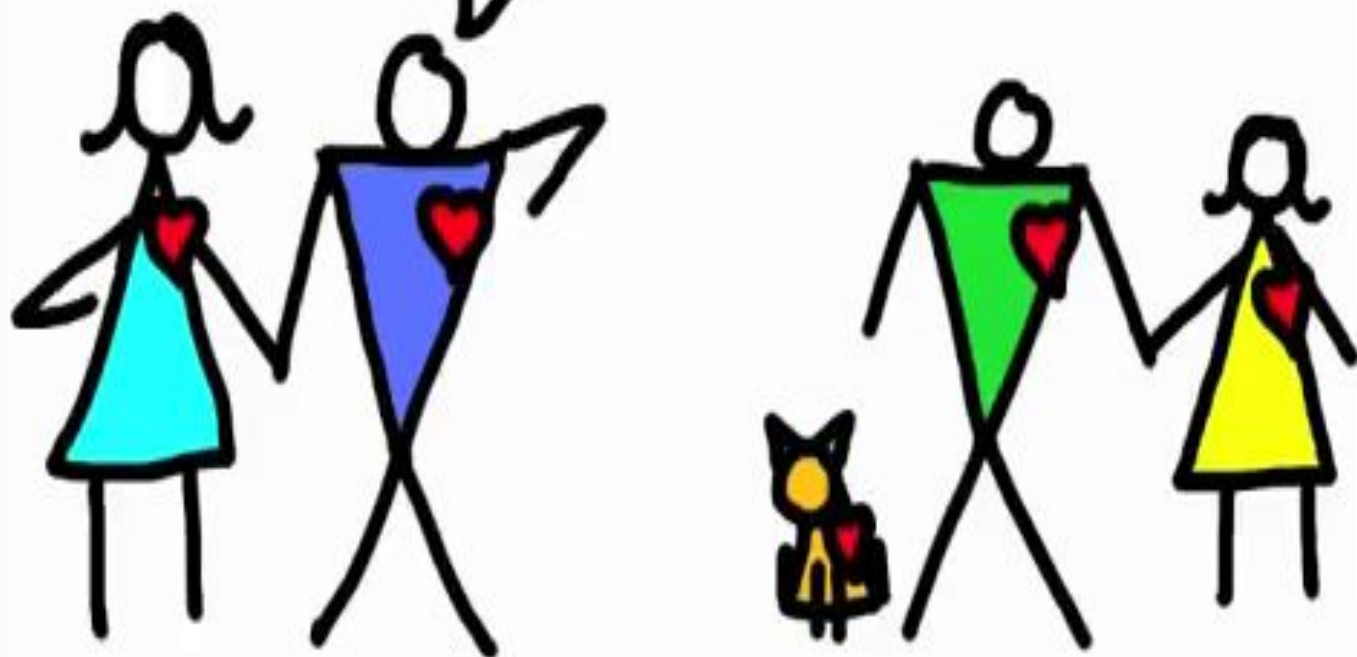
