It is broken

You are asked

You are broken

They are asked

They are broken

Simple Present

Active:

Rita writes a letter.

Passive:

The letter is written by Rita.

The letter is not written by Rita.

Is the letter written by Rita?

Passive Voice

Past Simple

to BE(was,were) + V3/V+ed

I **was not often** asked

I **was** broken

He **was** asked

He **was** broken

She **was** asked

She **was** broken

It **was** asked

It **was** broken

You **were** asked

You **were** broken

They **were** asked

They **were** broken

Simple Past

Active:

Rita wrote a letter.

Passive:

The letter was written by Rita.

The letter was not written by Rita.

Was the letter written by Rita?

Future Simple Passive:

next week-на следующей неделе, in a week-через неделю, tomorrow-завтра

WILL + BE + V3/V+ed

I will not often be asked

He will be asked

She will be asked

It will be asked

You will be asked

They will be asked

I will be broken

He will be broken

She will be broken

It will be broken

You will be broken

They will be broken

Future Simple

Active:

Rita will write a letter.

Passive:

The letter will be written by Rita.

The letter will not (=won't) be written by Rita.
