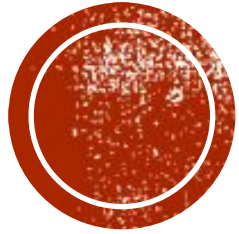


# **SPEECH BY SENATOR ROBERT F KENNEDY**

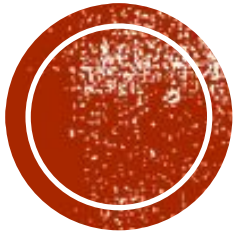


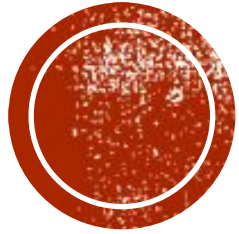


«Martin Luther King dedicated his life to love and to justice for his fellow human beings, and he died because of that effort». The main idea, which Senator Robert F Kennedy wanted to convey, connected with major problem between white and black people in the USA.



He described that Americans should make an “effort to understand and to comprehend, and to replace that violence in the world, the that with an effort to understand with compassion and love. That they have to make an effort in the United States, have to make an effort to understand, to go beyond these rather difficult times”.

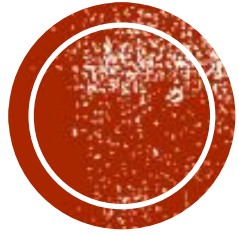




- He was the youngest person at the time to receive a Nobel Peace Prize
- From 1957 to 1968, King traveled over six million miles and spoke over 2,500 times
- The civil rights leader was arrested 29 times and assaulted four times
- King is the only non-president to have a national holiday in his name
- King was awarded 20 honorary degrees and was named Man of the Year by *Time* magazine
- There are approximately 900 streets named after MLK in the U.S.
- His mother was also murdered by a gunman
- King's last public speech foreshadowed his death

# Facts about Martin Luther King's life



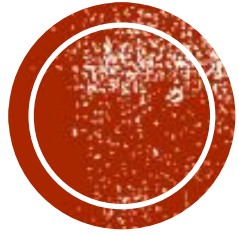
