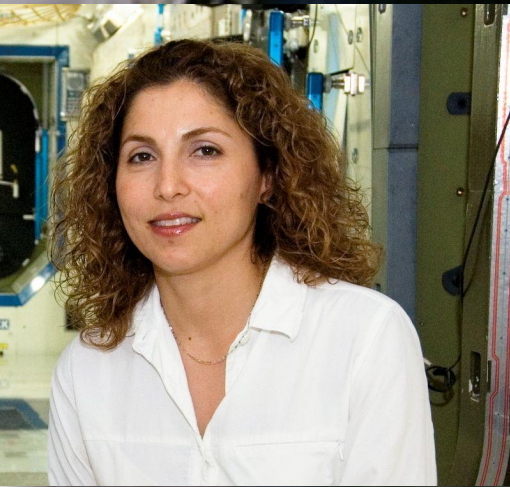

- 3) The second rocket launches a lunar living module and a propulsion module.
- 4) The Soyuz spacecraft docks with the Lunar Module in low-Earth orbit.
- 5) Return to Earth in a capsule
