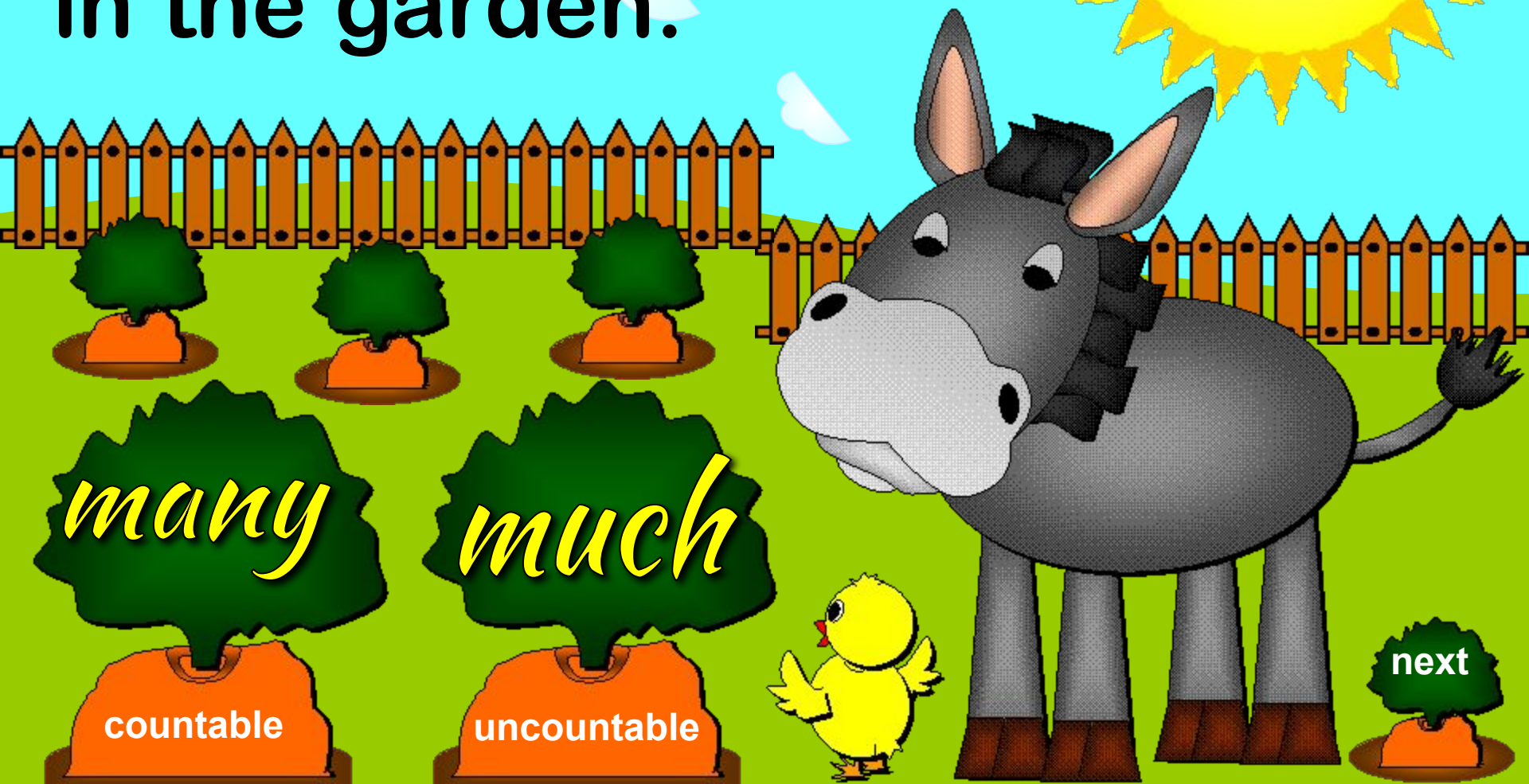

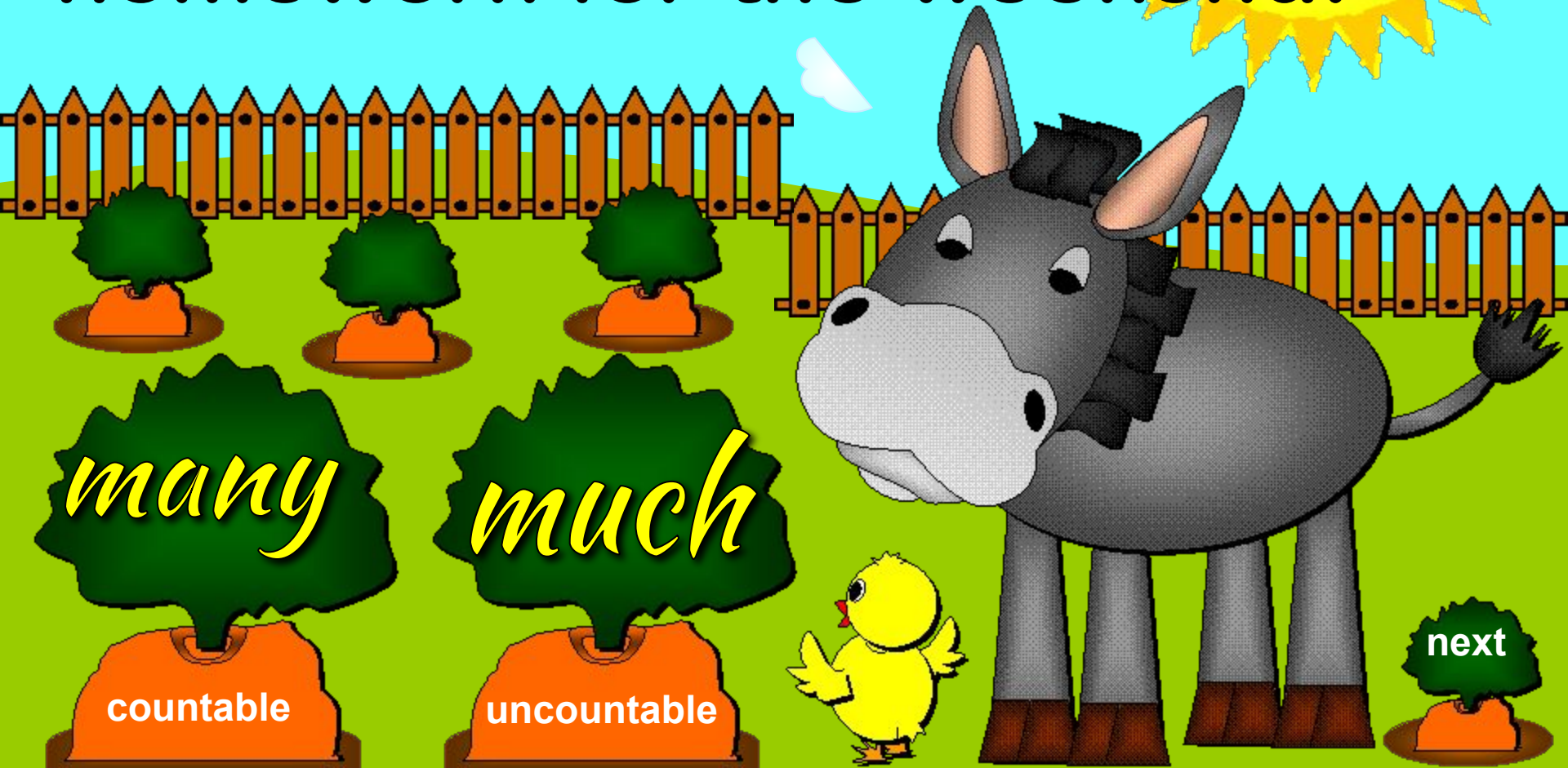

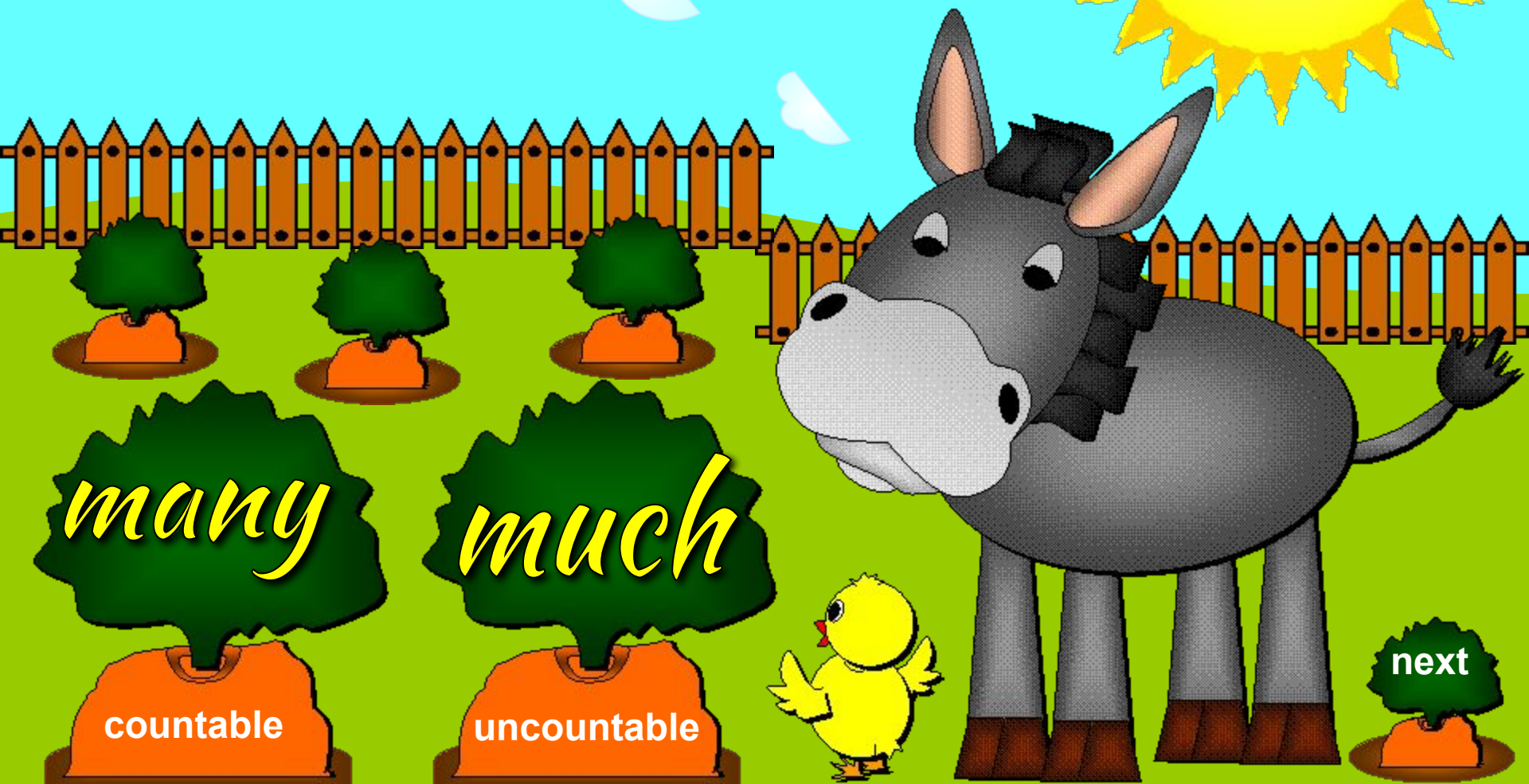

I don't eat **much** bread.



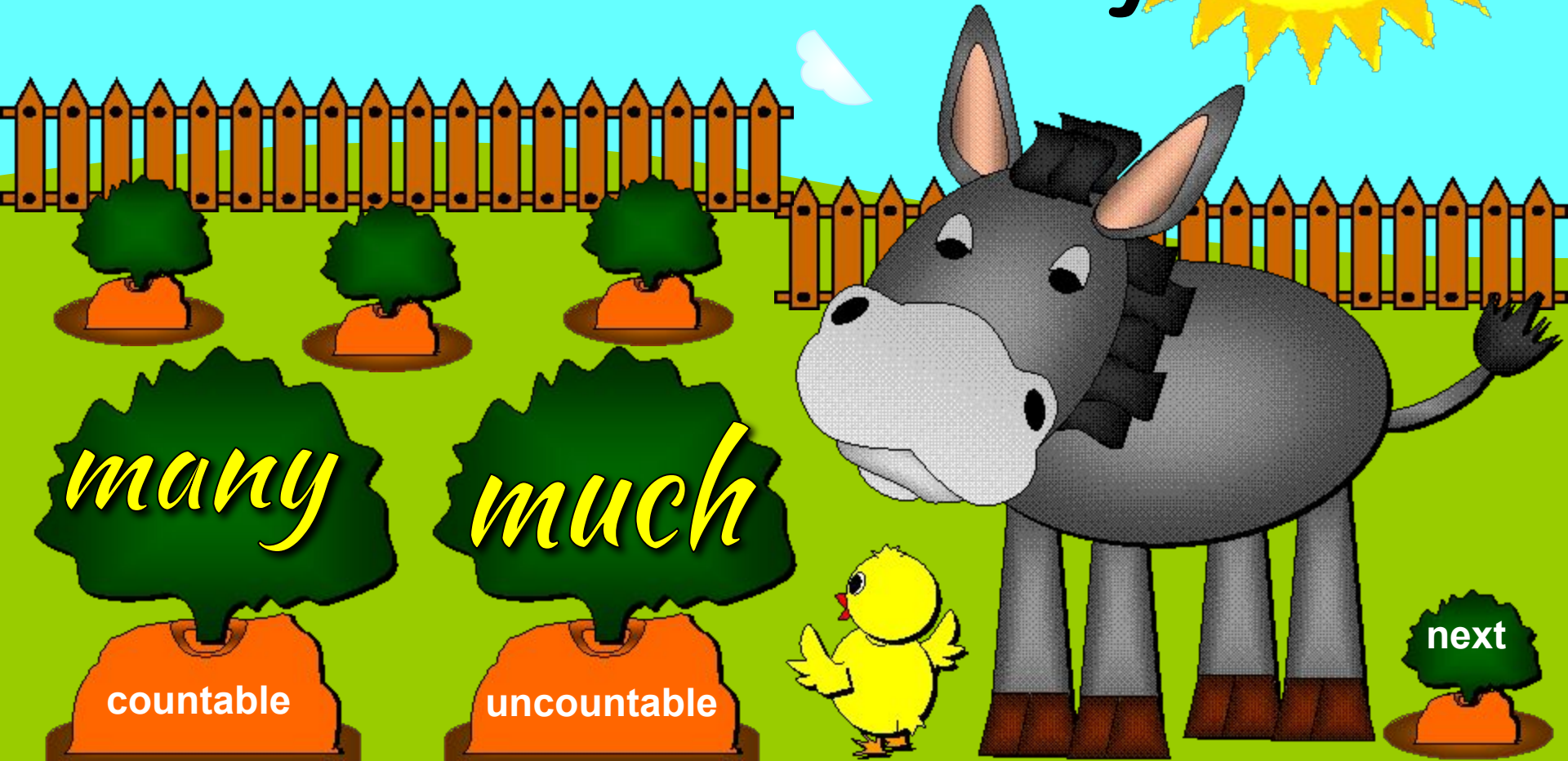

Look! There are **many** clouds in the sky today.



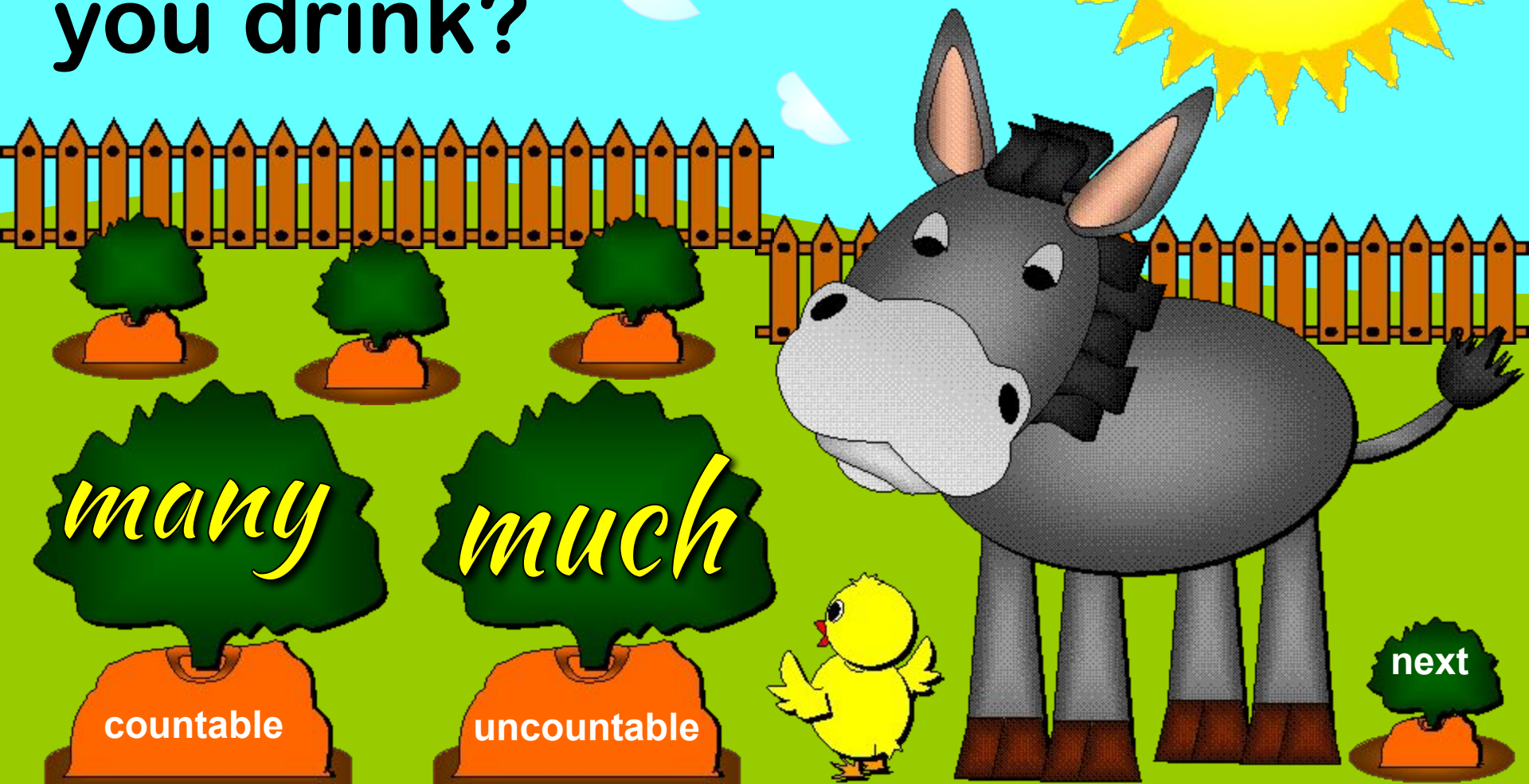
Count vs. Uncount

There isn't **much**..... sugar in the house. We need to buy some.



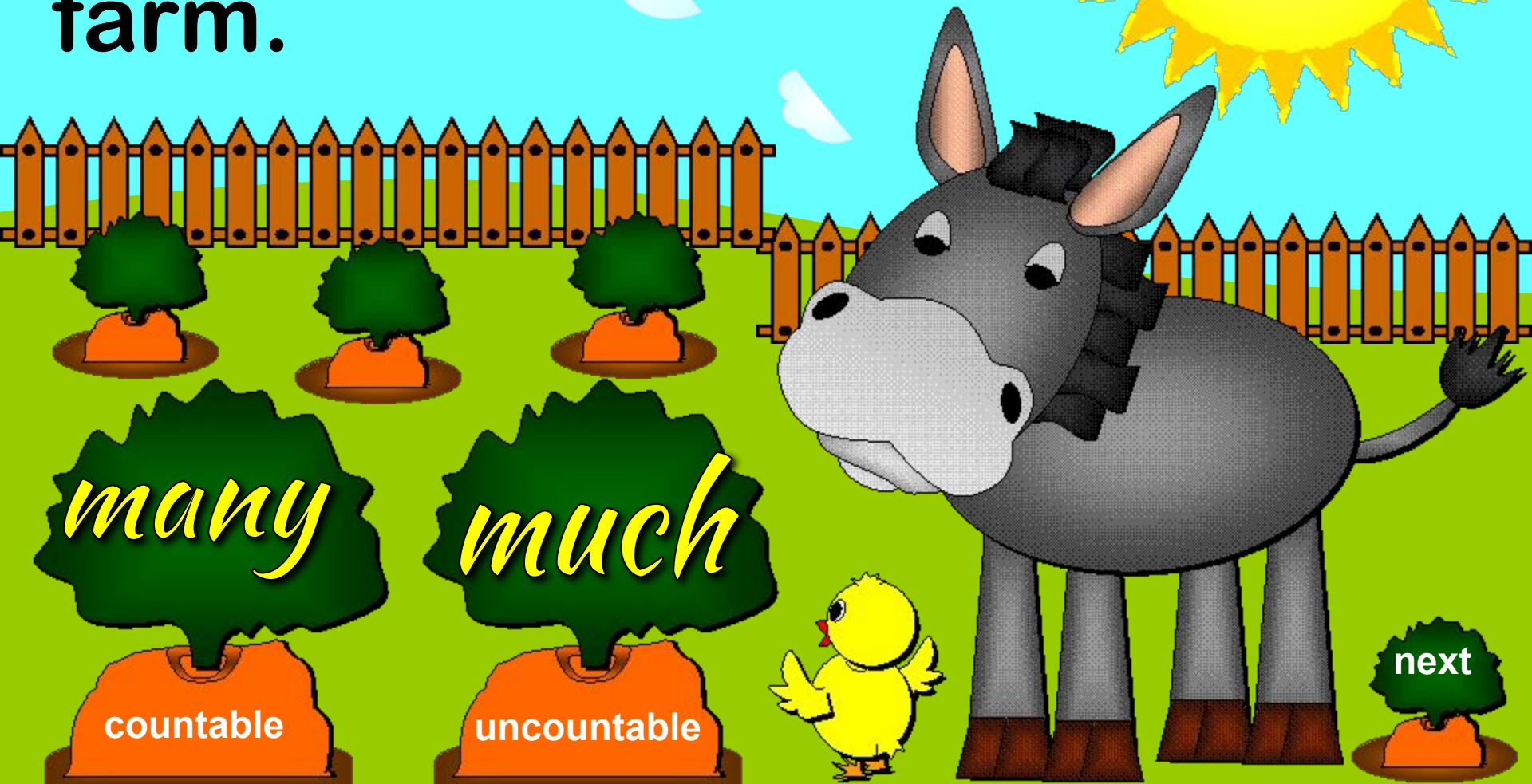

How **much** orange juice do you drink?



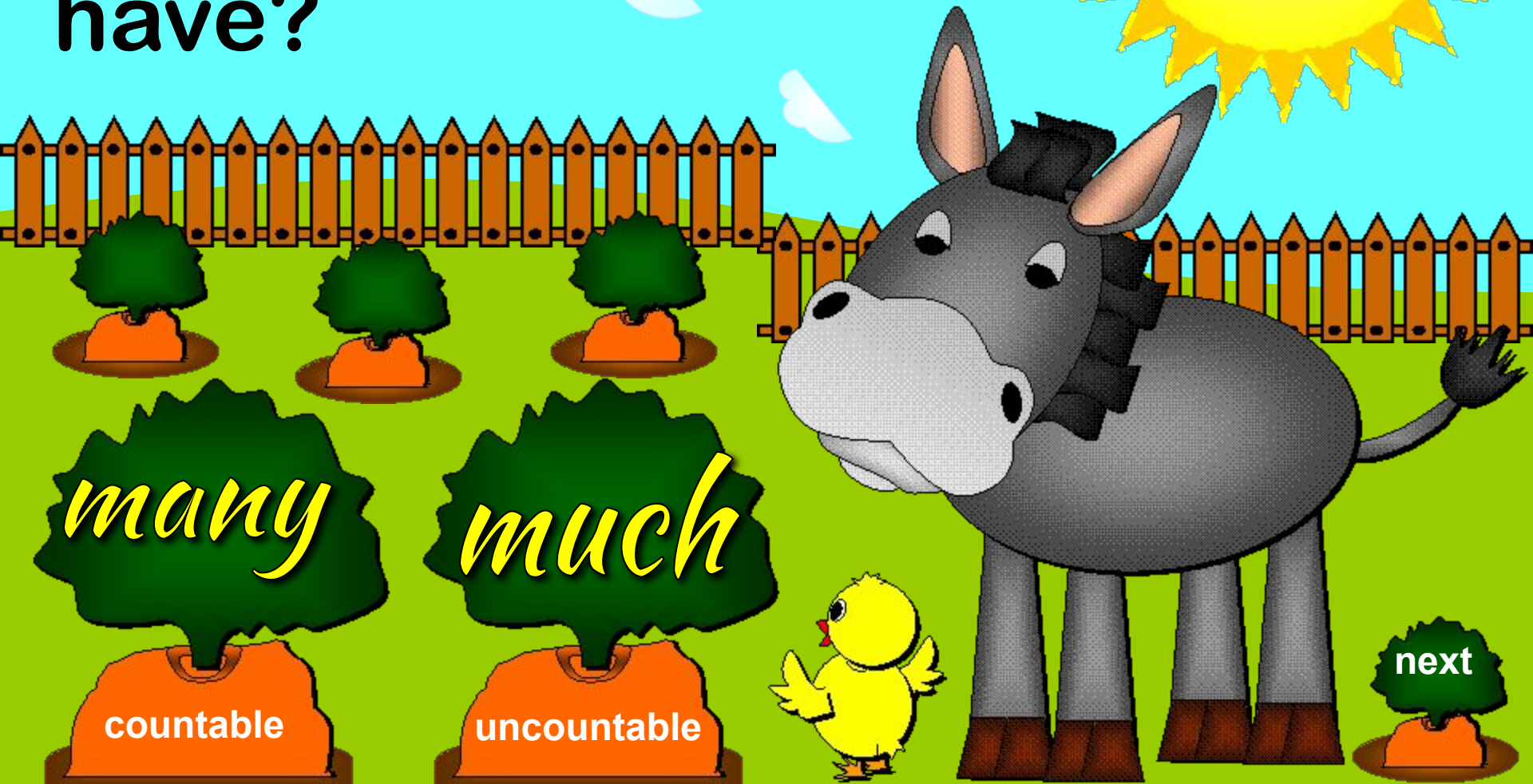

How **much** luggage do you have?



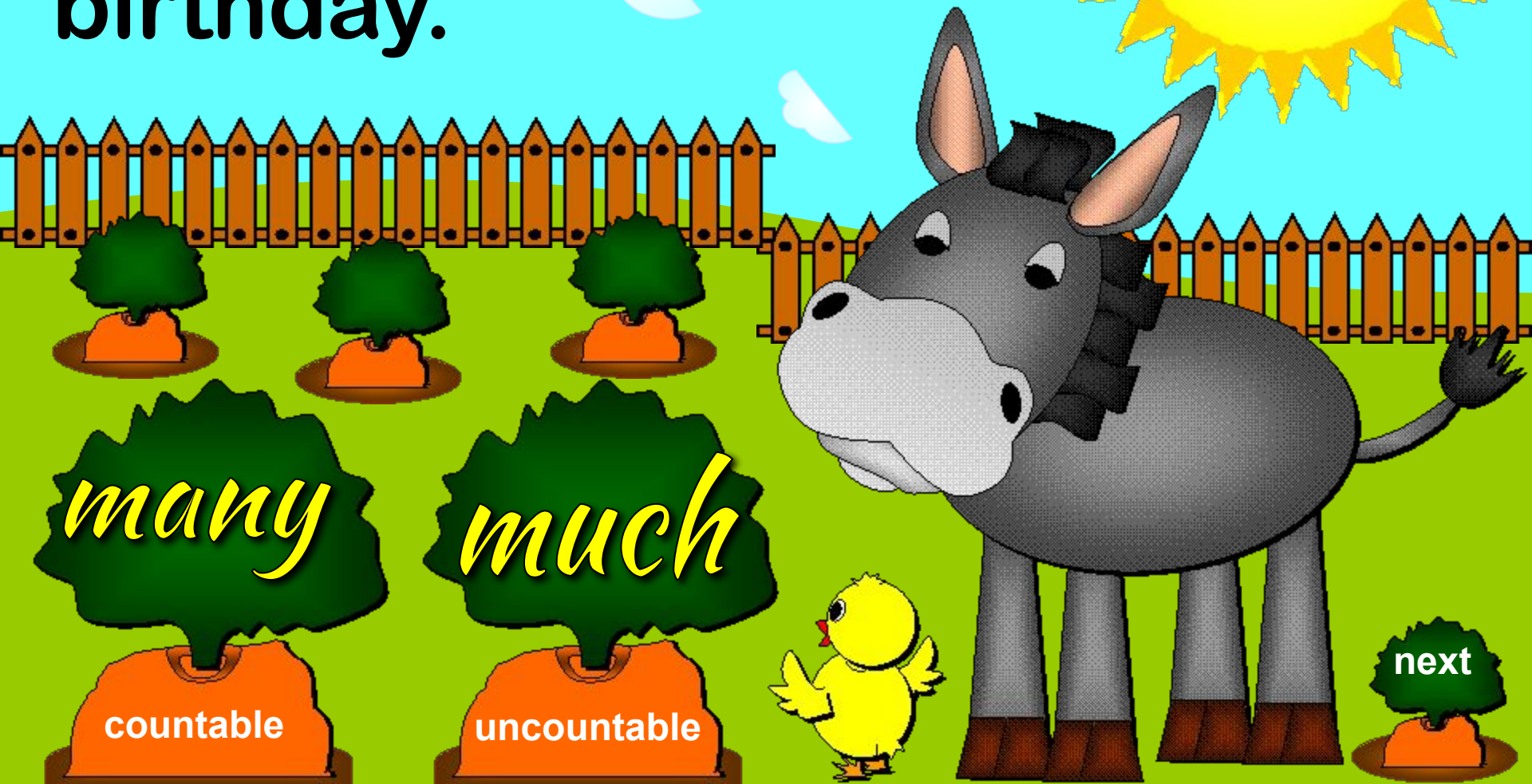
Count vs. UnCount

I've got **many** presents for my birthday.



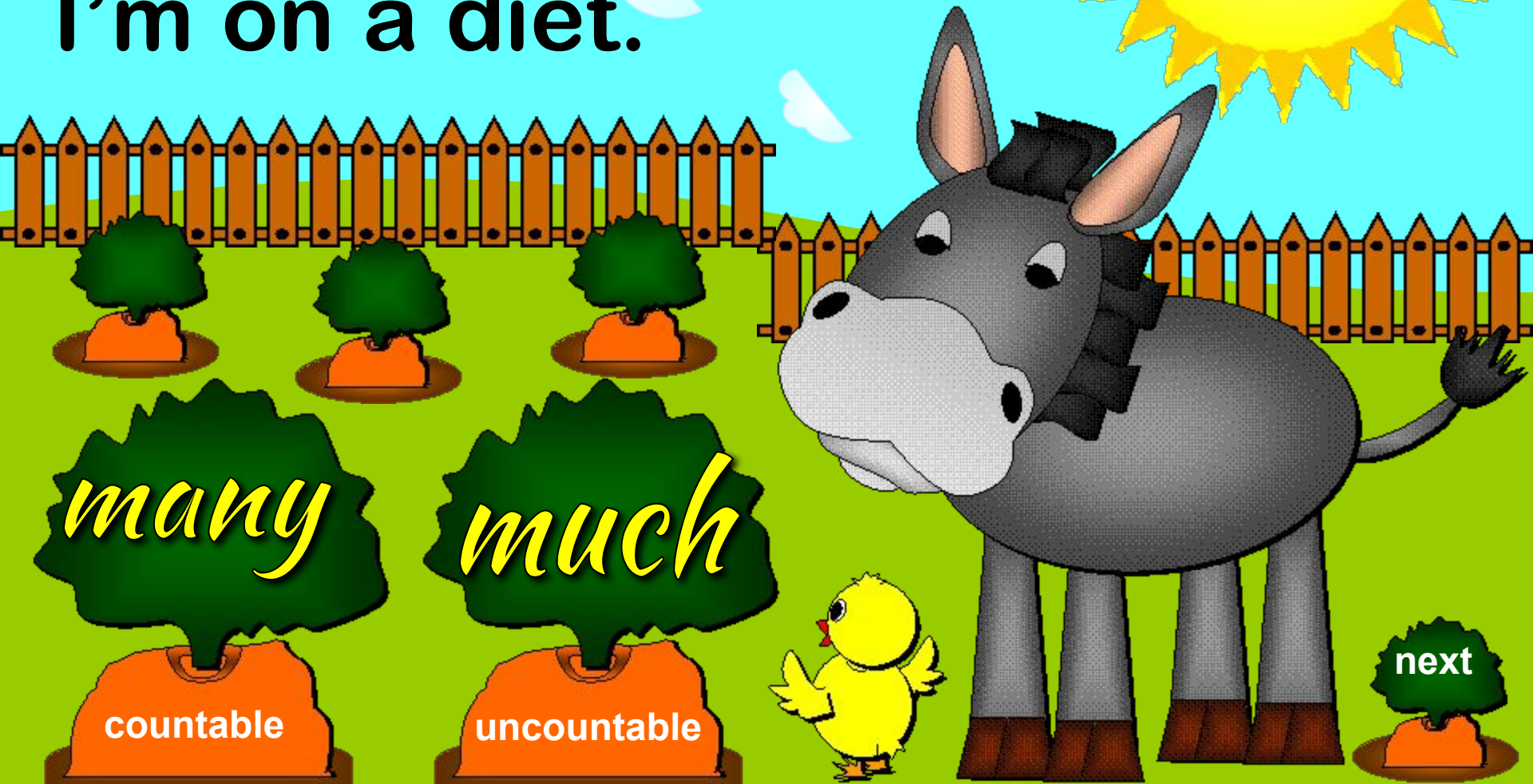
Count vs. UnCount
