Canada occupies a major northern portion of North America, sharing land borders with the contiguous United States to the south and the US state of Alaska to the northwest.


The Capital of Canada



Ottawa is the capital of Canada. One third of its people are French-speaking. The others are speaking in English





Canada also has many accessible services and different entertainments.








Capilano Suspension Bridge






Selin Dion was born in Canada, Quebec, Shurlemun.
