We add –er after
a vowel+consonant,
we double the final consonant.

Hot

Hotter

Big

Bigger

Fat

Fatter

We add –**r** to one-syllable
adjectives ending in –**e**.

Wide**e** Wider**r**

Late**e** Later**r**

Large**e** Larger**r**

We add **-ier** to
two-syllable adjectives after
a consonant+ **-y**.

Easy Easier

Early Earlier

Happy Happier

A few adjectives have
irregular comparative forms.

Good	Better
------	--------

Bad	Worse
-----	-------

★ We use the comparative form of adjectives to compare one person, thing, etc. with another.

comparative + than

**we use than after the
comparative**

The red house is bigger
than the blue house



He is taller
than me



A strawberry is smaller
than a pumpkin.
