Когда употребляется конструкция *to be going to*?

1. Когда заранее планируем что-либо сделать. (она собирается испечь торт; он собирается помыть машину)
2. Когда говорим о том, что что-то произойдет с большой вероятностью и для этого есть все признаки. (собираться дождь, посмотри на эти облака)

Формула построения предложения

Утвердительное предложение

I *am going to* сказуемое – I *am going to* watch TV.

He *is* going to

She *is* going to

It *is* going to

You *are* going to

We *are* going to

They *are* going to

Отрицательное предложение

I *am not going to* сказуемое – I *am not going to*
watch TV.

He *isn't* going to

She *isn't* going to

It *isn't* going to

We *aren't* going to

You *aren't* going to

They *aren't* going to

Вопросительное предложение

Am I *going to* сказуемое – Am I *going to* watch TV?

Is he going to...?

Is she going to?

Is it going to ...?

Are you going to ...?

Are we going to ...?

Are they going to ...?
