

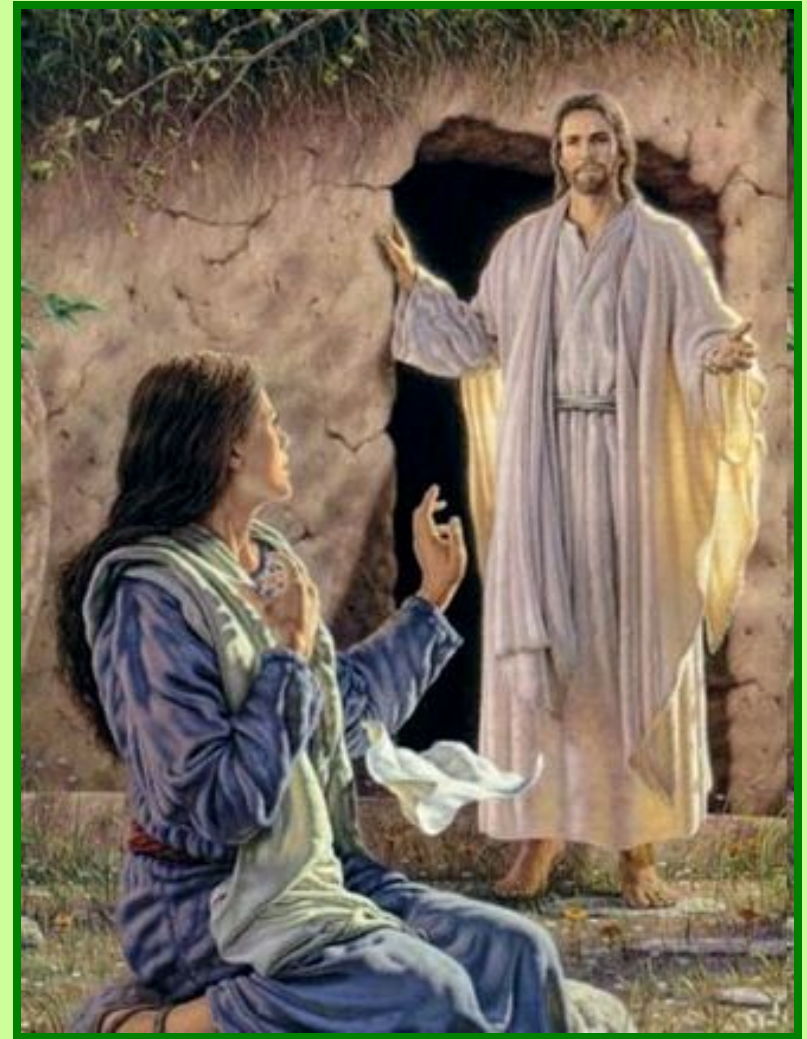

# The history of the holiday

*Easter* is a festival of  
overwhelming joy.

The joy that celebrates  
the victory of life over  
death. *Easter* celebrates  
the Resurrection of Jesus  
Christ on the third day  
after his Crucifixion.



# Easter Symbols

*Eggs and chicks*

symbolize new life. Eggs have been a symbol of spring since ancient times.



*The chick, hatching out of the egg, symbolizes new life or re-birth.*



*The exchange of eggs* in the springtime is a custom. From the earliest times, the egg was a symbol of birth in most cultures.

Today, children hunt colored eggs and place them in Easter baskets along with the modern version of real Easter eggs -- those made of plastic or chocolate candy.



***Easter bunny*** - The rabbit, or hare, was a symbol of new life in ancient times, and reminds us of spring and new life.



***Easter Lilies*** - The white blossoms symbolize the purity of Jesus. Lilies in the spring also symbolize new life.

***Easter hats*** and wearing  
new clothes for Easter-  
Symbolizes new life and  
the beginning of spring



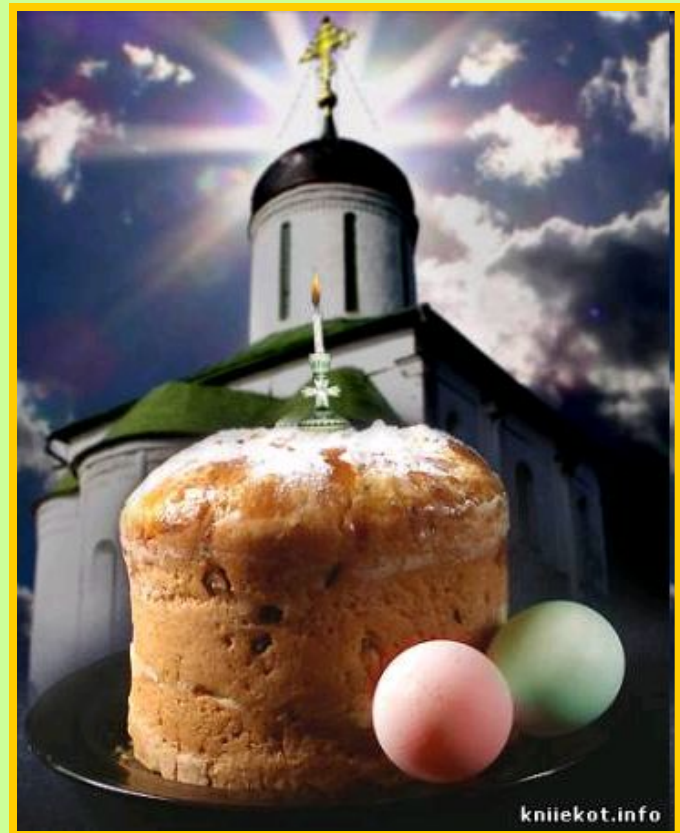
***The cross*** - Symbolizes Jesus'  
victory over death.



*Easter and Spring*  
*flowers-* Daffodils and  
tulips bloom in the  
spring, and symbolize  
spring and new life.



*Hot Cross Buns* - Hot cross  
buns have a cross of icing on  
the top to remind people  
of Christ.

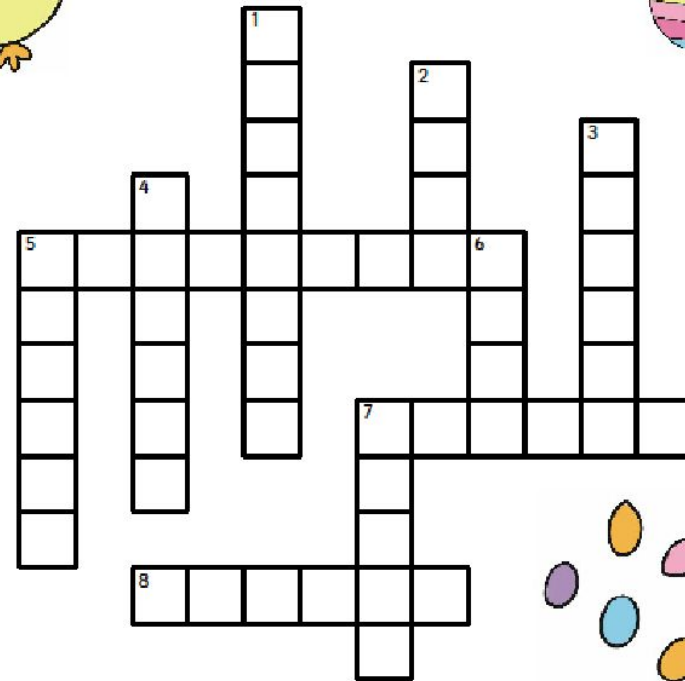

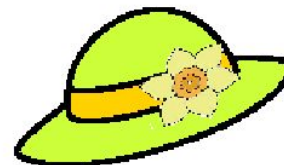
