


Easter in Great Britain

Easter Symbols

Eggs and chicks
symbolize new life. Eggs
have been a symbol of
spring since ancient
times.





The chick, hatching out of the egg, symbolizes new life or re-birth. The exchange of eggs in the springtime is a custom From the earliest times, the egg was a symbol of birth in most cultures.

Today, children hunt colored eggs and place them in Easter baskets along with the modern version of real Easter eggs—those made of plastic or chocolate candy.




Easter bunny - The rabbit, or hare, was a symbol of new life in ancient times, and reminds us of spring and new life.





Easter Lilies - The white blossoms symbolize the purity of Jesus. Lilies in the spring also symbolize new life.

The cross - Symbolizes Jesus' victory over death.

spring and new life.






Hot Cross Buns - Hot cross buns have a cross of icing on the top to remind people of Christ.


