#### February 2

# April 13 -May 8


The Velvet Revolution in Armenia.





### April 14

• a series of missile strikes by a coalition of the United States, Britain and France on a number of military and civilian facilities in Syria, committed as a response to a possible chemical attack made in the city of Duma in Eastern Ghouta (Russia regards these events as an aggressive attack)

Eurovision Song Contest 2018 (Lisbon, Portugal). Victory won the Israeli singer Netta Barzilai

## May 16

the opening of the Crimean Bridge (for the movement of cars and public transport)

















## June 14 - July 15

World Cup (Russia). The world champions for the second time was the French team, beating the Croatian team in the final

#### July 16

the first full-format meeting took place between Russian President Vladimir Putin and US President Donald Trump in Helsinki, the capital of Finland









The Patriarchate of Constantinople first intervened in the church situation in Ukraine: in violation of the resolutions adopted at the First Constantinople (Second Ecumenical) Council in 381, Patriarch Bartholomew sent two exarchs from North America to Ukraine, launching the creation process in Ukraine churches on the basis of the non-auto-kalphalononical Kyiv Patriarchate, which was not recognized by the local Orthodox churches, respectively, by splitting the Orthodox Church







## October 3

Russian President Vladimir Putin signed the Federal Law on Amendments to Pension Laws, among which the increase in the retirement age

weight category.


#### October 17
