

 Introduction to Bristol should start with the port - it was his heart. Thousands of people come every day to the port just to look at the ships and yachts.


The city is also rich in architecture. For example, a grand suspension bridge, an old Cabot Tower and magnificent church in Radcliffe district, which has laid 900 years ago.






## **MYSTERIOUS ORIGIN**
