1 Andrej Sakharov was born on the 21<sup>st</sup> of May, 1921 in Moscow.

2 Winston Churchill was born on the 30<sup>th</sup> of November, 1874 in Britain, in rich and famous family.

1 He graduated from the Moscow State University and became the most famous researchers in physics.

2 In 1895 he graduated from Sandhurst Military Academy and in five years time, in 1900, became a member of Parliament.

1 As a scientist he understood the danger of atomic wars and fought against them.

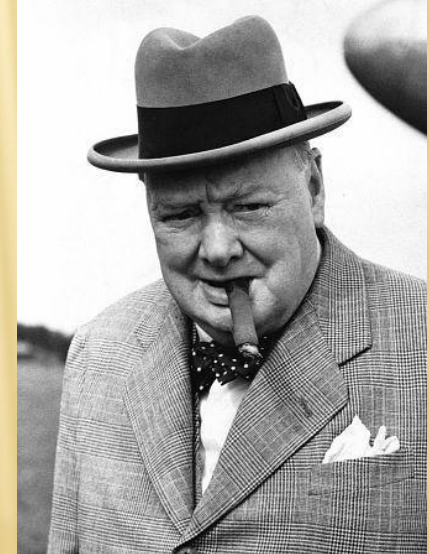
2 He was the Prime Minister during the Second World War.

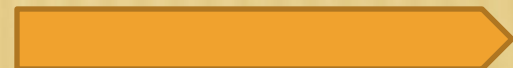
